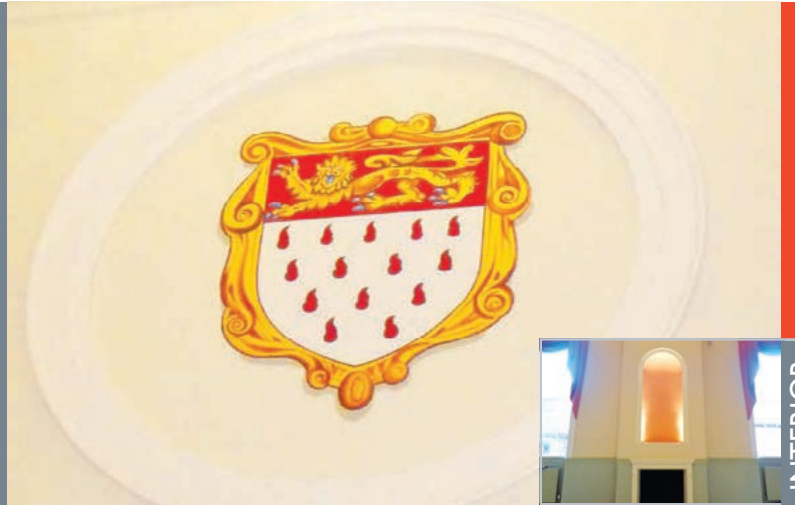

The Cairns Tower was part of the Sir Thomas Jackson Eastern Road Grand Entrance. During construction in 1880 the College ran out of money so work stopped at first floor level. The works were eventually completed in 2014, over one hundred years later.

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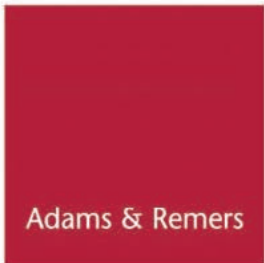

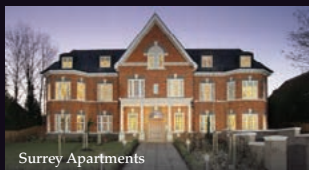

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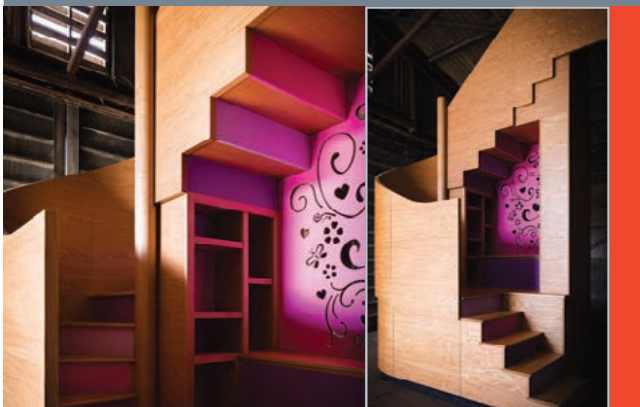
