

Introduction

E Pluribus Hugo (EPH) is a Hugo nomination counting method proposed and passed at the WSFS business meeting at Sasquan in 2015. It was intended to count nomination data in a way to reduce the impact of nominator minorities coordinating their submissions to attempt to control the final Hugo ballot (slates). The goal was to try to bring a block of voters down to controlling a representative portion of the ballot. It was also intended to leave ballots intact in cases where widespread coordinating was not present.

The proposal had been tested using modelled data, but was not run against live Hugo data.

The MidAmeriCon II Hugo administration team volunteered to assist with testing the EPH process against anonymized historical nominating data to determine the results of EPH in use for the Hugos. Towards this end, anonymized data sets were collected from Sasquan (2015) and Loncon 3 (2014 and 1939). EPH would be run against all three of these data sets. EPH will also be run against the 2016 and 1941 data sets collected by MidAmeriCon II, but those results will not be released until after the release of the full voting/nominating statistics after the 2016 Hugo ceremony on Saturday, August 20th.

Included in this document is the results of the analysis of the three previously existing nomination data sets. Each category will show its nomination long list details compared against the long list that would be produced if EPH had been the counting method in place.

In testing, it was identified that the results in two categories (Dramatic Presentation, Long and Short Form) were usually producing results with many nominators submitting matching entries to other nominators. This was more due to the smaller pool to nominate from compared to other categories than any external coordination of nominating ballots. As such, we decided to produce results with these categories excluded, as changes in the dramatic presentation categories aren't as useful for gauging if EPH is acting as appropriate where desired as the other categories would be.

The results are listed showing the full ordered list, but we're focusing on simple changes in presence on the ballot or the long list. We're not concerning ourselves with changes to the *ordering* of either the ballot or the long list. If something is removed from or added to the ballot, we note that as a significant change. Anything added to or removed from the long list is noted as a minor change. We understand that nominees/finalists might care greatly about their ranked position on either the ballot or long list, but we don't feel that changes in order of the list are germane to determining the effectiveness of EPH.

When items are added to the long list that had previously not been present on the long list, and therefore not made public, the resulting entry in our listing is anonymized.

EPH Analysis 2015 Hugo Nomination Analysis

Introduction

Sasquan in 2015 saw the emergence of a successful attempt to control the Hugo ballot. Nominators coordinating with each other enabled a small minority (less than 20%) of the nominating members to gain 62 of the 70 top positions across 14 categories of the Hugo ballot.

EPH was specifically intended to bring the control of the ballot by a coordinating minority of the nominators down to a representative size for the group participating. As this nominating data is the case EPH was intended for, it is expected that EPH will make its largest number of changes with this data.

The nominating data for 2015 is comprised just under 5,000 entries submitted by 2,100 nominators across the 17 categories.

It is evident that EPH does have an effect. 12 of the 15 tracked categories experienced some change to its Ballot or Long List. In the 15 categories tracked, there were 14 ballot positions that had an effective change, or just under one ballot position altered per category. There were 10 Long List entries changed, also changing just under one position per category. This effect, while visible, is not of a scale to bring the ballot in line with the number of nominators coordinating their submissions. A single coordinated minority of less than 20% would still average controlling over 80% of the ballot.

EPH Analysis 2014 Hugo Nomination Analysis

Introduction

The Hugo nomination process for Loncon 3 in 2014 was absent of any group effort to control the majority of the ballot. It is fairly representative of a year in which nomination stuffing did not occur, so the goal would be for EPH to not make significant changes to the ballot.

The 2014 process had nominations from 1,923 members submitting over 4,000 entries across the 17 award categories.

EPH changed all but two long lists. Only the 2014 JWC contest was not altered by counting using EPH. Additionally, 3 ballots were altered by EPH counting. Two were altered by ties being eliminated that removed qualifying candidates and two by candidates being replaced by entries that were previously present on the long list (one ballot was affected by both behaviors). For a data set where no ballot changes were necessarily anticipated, changing one out of every 3 ballots (on average) is much higher than expected, as is changing just over one Long List entry per category.

EPH Analysis 1939 Hugo Nomination Analysis

Introduction

The 1939 process had nominations from 233 members submitting over 900 entries across 9 award categories. The retrospective aspect of things resulted in even less incentive to game the ballot than might be present in any current Hugo year.

It would be expected that EPH would make very few changes to the Retro process.

EPH altered fewer ballots with the reduced nominator/entry counts. Two categories had their ballots changed. The long list changes suggested by EPH would not be made as the preclusion from showing entries with less than 5 nominations **would** keep the items from being shown on the long list...the entries are included merely to show that such a swap might have occurred. While fewer changes to the ballots were registered, this was still an average of one ballot change for every four categories when none were necessarily anticipated.

EPH Analysis Conclusions from Testing

Dave McCarty's Conclusions

EPH does have a measurable effect on the resulting ballots and long lists if it is implemented. The issue is that it is both less and more active than was suggested when the system was proposed.

Where nominator coordination is present, it does generally result in the swapping of **one** position on the ballot with an item that was not on the ballot. It does not, however, eliminate a number of entries to bring the coordinated nomination block down to a representative size. This allows a small minority to continue to control almost the entire ballot. Additionally, the items that are removed from the ballot are in high positions on the long list waiting to be added back into the ballot if any of the prospective finalists decline or are found to be ineligible (which you can see happens with some regularity).

Where nominator coordination is **not** present, there are still significant numbers of changes not only to the long list, but to ballots where it's not generally considered for anything untoward to have happened. Items removed from the 2014 ballot included a **winner** of the Hugo. Had EPH been in place, they would not have been on the ballot. Without nomination coordination present, EPH resulted in changing one in every three or four ballots on average where the goal would be to leave the ballot as is.

The changes to the Ballot and Long list are not easily verified and for people reviewing the detailed results at the end the only way to check that the process is working correctly would require access to secret nomination data and significant time. The difficulty in verification means that to check any result requires time which is **NOT** available to award administrators when it is time to close the nominating and prepare for the Ballot announcement. These are significant hurdles for a process that is generally designed to be open and democratic.


This method of trying to resolve the issue of nomination coordination does not offer enough benefit to offset the hurdles it puts in place. There appear to be other suggestions available that will be more successful at addressing the problem and do them in manners that are possibly far more open and democratic.

Jamison Quinn's Conclusions

I believe EPH shows it has a measurable effect to limit the ability of a slate of coordinated nominators from controlling the entire Hugo ballot. Even should we decide to adopt the currently pending 3SV proposal or something like it, I believe that at least EPH is still necessary to prevent a slate from taking over the Long List. Here is the number of Long List slots a slate could get, averaged across 6 categories, assuming very weak ability to coordinate. Under ideal coordination ability, things would be much worse; they could get similar results with just about half the numbers shown on the x axis.

EPH Analysis

Slate finalists as a function of pseudo-slate voters



"SDV-LPE" is EPH; "SDV-LPE-SL" is EPH+; and "SDV" is a version of EPH which eliminates based on points and not approvals (and thus encourages bullet voting). (Note: ignore the "(out of 5)" in the label for the y axis.)

The lesson of the graph above is that even an imperfectly-coordinated slate could leave fewer than 5 organic results on the Long List, swamping 3SV, with as few as 300 voters; something that would take over 800 voters under EPH+.
