# Overview

#### **Northeast Florida and Southeast Georgia**



## Through Late Afternoon:

- Winter Storm Warning for all of Southeast GA and portions of Suwannee Valley and I-10 Corridor west of Jacksonville.
- Dangerous ice storm expected from Live Oak and Lake City northeastward to Homerville, Waycross, and Nahunta.
- Significant snow accumulations of 2"-4" expected from Alma to Jesup and points north and west in southeast GA, with locally higher amounts up to 6" possible in Wayne, Bacon and Appling Counties.
- Winter Weather Advisory for portions of inland NE FL, where mixed precipitation is expected.
- Coastal Flood Advisory and High Surf Advisory along the NE FL coast through 1 PM. Minor coastal flooding possible during the mid morning high tide cycle, especially in St. Johns and Flagler Counties.
- Gale Warning for the offshore waters, Small Craft Advisory for near shore waters.



# Possible Impacts

**Northeast Florida and Southeast Georgia** 



- Downed trees and power lines may result in widespread electrical outages where significant ice accumulations are forecast, generally in a corridor from Live Oak and Lake City to Homerville, Waycross and Nahunta.
- The cold ground temperature causes rainfall to freeze upon impact, thus creating ice and slick conditions, especially on elevated road surfaces and bridges.
- Black ice may become a more widespread impact early this evening as precipitation ends and temperatures dive below freezing. This threat may extend into the metropolitan Jacksonville area.



# **Potential Impacts**

- General 0.25" to 0.50" of ice expected from Live Oak and Lake City to Waycross and Nahunta.
- 0.10" to 0.25" ice
   accumulations in the vicinity of
   Brunswick.
- 2 to 4 inches of snow from Alma to Jesup with local 6" totals in Wayne, Bacon and Appling Counties.



## **Total Liquid Precipitation**



## **Forecast Precipitation**











### Ice Accumulation Probabilities






### 0.10" Ice Accumulation Probabilities

## .25" Ice Accumulation Probs






### **Snow Accumulation Probabilities**






### 2" Snow Accumulation Probabilities

# Outlook

### **Northeast Florida and Southeast Georgia**



- Tonight through Saturday
  - Continued COLD temperatures through Saturday.
  - Hard Freeze Warning and Wind Chill Advisory for all of southeast GA and all of northeast and north central FL tonight through Thursday morning.
  - Exposure to cold can cause frostbite or hypothermia and become life-threatening. Watch for Black Ice tonight.
  - Wind chills in the teens during the overnight and early morning hours from Wednesday night through early Saturday morning.
  - Additional widespread hard freezes Thursday night/Friday morning and again Friday night/Saturday morning.
  - Small Craft Advisory on the coastal waters through Thursday.






#### Hard Freeze Warning and Wind Chill Advisory Tonight


