Statue of St Andrew erected in 1791 and sculpted by Vincezo Dimech. The statue is detailed and very artistic, although paint has covered some of these attributes. The figure of St Andrew is seen leaning on to the saltire cross and has a metal halo. It stands on a simple pedestal installed with a lamp and an inscription granting a 40day indulgence by Bishop Vincenzo Labini.
