SMART Goal 1 - Subject Area: Math

Our SMART Goal: The percentage of all grade 3-5 students meeting standard on the SBA Math assessment will increase from 84.3% to 89% in 2020.

SMART Goal 2 - Subject Area: ELA

Our SMART Goal: The percentage of all grade 3-5 students meeting standard on the SBA ELA assessment will increase from 79.9% to 84% in 2020.

Action Step: Teachers will increase levels of student engagement

SMART Goal 3 - Subject Area: Cultural Competence and Awareness

<u>Our SMART Goal</u>: On the CEE Survey, the percentage of all grade 4-5 students and staff who identify almost always/often true that the school provides activities that recognize that each racial/cultural group has it's own strengths and needs will increase from 59% (students) - 48% (staff) to 80% (students and staff) by 2020.

Our PTA is second to none! We have a large PTA who helps raise money to support all of our programs at Lakeland Hills including:

They provide services to our students and families such as: a Giving Tree that support families in need; Pat-on-the-Back, a student recognition program. Our PTA organizes many social events for our families including: a school-wide carnival; father/ daughter dance; Family Fun Nights (Mariner games, Sounders, Thunderbirds, movie nights) and organizes staff appreciation events throughout the year.

LAP PROGRAM

Lakeland Hills is a Learning Assistance Program (LAP) school. LAP programs serve eligible students who need academic support for reading, writing and math, or who need readiness skills to learn these core subjects. With special emphasis on reading literacy in grades K-4, schools use their state LAP funds to deliver supplemental services that give these students the strong start they need for academic success.




OUT STUDENT COMMUNITY AT LAKELAND HILLS



MATH - Grades 3, 4 & 5




SCIENCE - Grade 5
