Entries

All players in the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament is to be conducted.

The organisers will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this Tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned.

All International entries are to be submitted online by the competitors National Badminton Association (M.A).

The online entry page will automatically close on <u>Tuesday 27 March 2018 at 23:59 hours</u> BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) Late entries will not be accepted.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday 29 March (second day after the entries closing day) 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.











New Zealand Player Entries

New Zealand players should enter online through the New Zealand Players only link available on the Badminton NZ website; entries will close Thursday 22 March 2018 entry fees must be paid by this date

New Zealand players entry fee is NZ\$125 per person regardless of number of events entered. NZ Players must be a member of an Association registered to Badminton New Zealand. An entry fee will entitle a player to access to the venue and practise areas until Thursday 03rd May and to public areas only from Friday 04th – Sunday 06th May 2018. Players who are still in the tournament from Friday onwards will be issued a new accreditation pass.

Competition Rules and Regulations

The BWF General Competition regulations will apply except where specific provisions are contained in the Regulations for the World Tour. Where there is any conflict or apparent conflict, the World Tour Regulations will take precedence. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.

Withdrawals

Withdrawals will be managed according to the BWF regulations.

Withdrawals after Monday 09 April 2018 shall automatically attract withdrawal fees as per BWF regulations.

Withdrawals until this date must be initiated through online entry system by logging on to the tournament link used for sending the entry. Withdrawals after that date must be informed by e-mail to julie@nzbadmintonopen.com and the Referee: David Chang: tele2709@ms4.hinet.net as soon as possible.

Withdrawals after players arrive in the venue city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager to the Referee in writing.

Mixed Doubles First Round Main Draws will be played on Tuesday after the qualifying round has finished. The Mixed Doubles pairs who come through from the qualifying round will play their first main round match on Wednesday.

The start times on Tuesday and Wednesday will be determined by the number of entries, the earliest start time will be 9am.

All matches will be scheduled to time. Players must be available to play 10 minutes before their scheduled time.

Meeting Times

The Managers meeting will be held at the Spencer on Byron Hotel on Monday 30 April at 4pm

As per BWF regulations all countries to ensure they have a representative at this meeting.

It is compulsory that all team managers must attend the team managers meeting. Failing to attend the meeting an MA is liable to be fined as per BWF regulations. Member Associations can make a request for someone to represent them at the meeting as the Referee is advised in advance.

The Technical Officials meeting will be held at the North Shore Events Centre on Monday 30 April at 7pm

Practice Courts

Practice courts (4 match courts and 3 warm-up courts) at the tournament venue will be arranged by the Organiser. Court allocation will be based on the number of players in the team and done on a fair and equitable basis. Courts are available in the venue as from 09:00 Monday 30 April 2018.

Requests for practice courts at the practice venue, Badminton North Harbour Centre (11 courts), can be made on the practice court booking form or at the liaison desk at the Spencer on Byron Hotel upon arrival. Courts are available as from Sunday 29 April 2018.











Courts are subject to availability and on a first served basis. Tournament transport will be provided to this venue for players and officials staying at the Spencer on Byron Hotel.

Transport

The closest airport is Auckland International Airport.

Following the close of entries, a transport form will be emailed to team managers requesting flight details.

Details must be provided <u>no later than 20 April 2018</u> for pick-up to be arranged. Any request after this date <u>will not</u> be accepted. Requests for a refund of taxi charges will not be entertained.

Transport will only be provided to players and officials staying at the official Hotel – Spencer on Byron Hotel.

This includes airport pick-up and drop-off, transport to the practice and the tournament venues.

Accreditation

Once entries have closed an accreditation form will be sent to all Team Managers for their attention and return, including a jpg head and shoulders photo of all people requiring accreditation, to be submitted by 20 April 2018.

Entry to the arena for the players, coaches and officials will be by accreditation pass or ticket only, please carry your accreditation with you at all time.

Lost accreditation passes will be replaced for a fee of NZ\$100 each

The maximum number of officials' and coaches' accreditation passes issued to each team is according to the following:

Number of Accompanying Officials	2	3	4	5	6

There will be a limited number of additional accreditation passes available for NZ\$100 each (maximum 5 per team). These must be applied for through the tournament office – the organising committee has the right to decline requests at their sole discretion.

Mis-use use of an accreditation pass may result in the confiscation of the pass.

Visas

If a visa is required to enter New Zealand, please complete the Visa Form and email to admin@nzbadmintonopen.com by 10 April 2018. Letters cannot be provided after this date.

Clothing and Advertising

Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the current BWF General Competition Regulations

Players should ensure that they read these regulations and that their clothing complies.











Doping Control

The BWF Anti-Doping Regulations apply.

Medical Services

A tournament doctor will be available at the tournament venue during the times of play.

Physiotherapy services will be available on days of play during the event at the venue free of charge however players may be required to complete an ACC form

Presentation Ceremonies

Players are not allowed to wear hats or caps during the presentation ceremonies. Rackets may not be carried during presentations. Tracksuits, or clothing as worn during play, will be allowed. No other form of advertising will be permitted. This regulation will be strictly enforced by our stewards prior to each ceremony.

Video Recording and Photography

Badminton New Zealand and the organisers reserve the rights to take photographs and film images of players during the event.

No unauthorised persons may enter the playing arena to video record or take photographs without the prior approval of Badminton New Zealand or the tournament organisers

Flash photography is not permitted in the venue

Video recording is permitted for analytical purposes only and only by tournament accredited players and officials of competing Member Associations. The tournament organisers shall designate positions the cameras are permitted to be placed and they must display video passes as issued by the tournament organisers. Cameras operating outside of the designated area or without the correct accreditation may be removed.
