Following a bachelor's degree in Zoology from University of Delhi (1973), Gaiti Hasan pursued her Master's (1978) and M.Phil (1980) studies in Life Sciences from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. She moved to University of Cambridge and pursued her Ph.D studies on ribosomal RNA genes of Trypanosoma brucei (1983). Following her Ph.D at Cambridge, she joined as a visiting fellow at the Molecular Biology Unit of TIFR, Mumbai (1986) and continued there as a Research associate (1991). She served as visiting scientist at the Dept. of Biology, Brandeis University, Waltham, Massechuessets (1992). She then returned to India and joined as Fellow at NCBS, Bangalore and was appointed as Reader in 1994. She continues there as Professor. She has many international and national publications to her credit. So far she has mentored 10 Ph.D students and at present 7 more Ph.D students are continuing with her.

Prof. Hasan's major area of research interest is InsP3 and Calcium signaling in neuronal function. She has been elected member of both the Indian National Science Academy as well as the Indian Academy of Science. She has been also selected as member of the Asia-Pacific Molecular Biology Network. Prof. Hasan has served as member of the editorial board for various Journals in the field of Neuroscience. This year has been bestowed with the "Chaire Joliot" Visiting Scientist position at the ESPCI, Paris Tech conducted by CNRS, Paris, France.
