Information Letter 999 Publication of the 48th Amendment to the IFRA Code of Practice – Timeline Confirmation

Dear Colleagues,

The 48th Amendment to the IFRA Code of Practice was notified to the Member Associations on June 10, 2015. We recognized some minor issues which nevertheless justified to publish a corrigendum, which was distributed on July 10, 2015. Due to this update, we have slightly adjusted the timeline for IFRA 48 implementation as follows:

Now through August 10, 2015	Exchange of information between fragrance houses
September 10, 2015*	In force for submissions on projects briefed after this date
Nov. 10, 2015*	Customers informed of status for existing products
Jan. 10, 2016	Specification changes in force for submissions on projects
	briefed after this date
August 10, 2016*	In force for existing products
Jan. 10, 2017	Specification changes in force for existing products

^{*}These dates apply to all limiting or ban related standards. Specification standards have an extended deadline.

The timing refers to the mixture of fragrance ingredients, the so called fragrance compound, not the finished consumer product.
