Manly Beach - Ocean Front Promenade





Battle at the Beaches is Australia's first outdoor cheerleading competition, and we are excited to now be holding the event at Manly Beach!

We are very pleased to be offering bids to the AASCF Australasian Pinnacle, held in Melbourne in 2017!

The event is being held on **Sunday November 5th** on the **Manly Beach**, **Ocean Front Promenade**, opposite The Corso. This event is cheer only, and will be on a full size sprung floor. Warm up will be located a short walk from the competition area and check in will be at the Royal Far West School, 22 Wentworth St, Manly.

In the event of rain, the competition will move to a venue TBC. Coaches will be notified on Saturday 4th if the event is going to be moved. If there is light rain on the day we will cover the floor and wait, which will mean a delay in the schedule. Please make your athletes aware of the potential for this.

All judges are highly qualified and experienced with the AASCF judging system so they will be able to provide valuable feedback for you to use before Nationals.

Competitive categories offered are Cheer (All Star and Scholastic including Novice) Group Stunt and Partner Stunt. Age divisions and levels are as per the AASCF/IASF Rules.

The competition judging will be based on the current USASF/IASF Cheer and Rules, i.e. the same as the rules being used at AASCF Nationals.



Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in all cheer categories. Medallions will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in group and partner stunt. Grand Champion surfboards will be given in Novice, levels 1, 2, 3, 4, 4.2, 5 and 6.

All athletes receive a participation medal.

Entries

Entry cost is \$50 per athlete for one routine, plus \$15 for each additional routine.

If athletes are entered only in group or partner stunt the cost is just \$35.

If team numbers drastically increase this year, we may move Group and Partner Stunt events to a nearby location in Manly and run them concurrently. Preference for the beachfront competition floor will be given to teams.

All competing athletes must sign the attached waiver (or have it signed by a parent or guardian if under 18).

Entries close 4 weeks before the event.

Payments can be made by Visa, MasterCard, internet transfer or cheque mailed to 22/130 Old Pittwater Rd, Brookvale 2100. Credit Card payments attract a 1% fee.

Warm Up

Warm up will be located a short walk from the competition area.

Spectator Entry

Spectator entry will be free for standing room and VIP bleachers will be available for a cost of \$5 per person. (Cash only)



Music

Team's music should be brought by coaches/managers on the day on an iPod only. Coaches are responsible for playing the music for their own teams.

Awards

Please ensure athletes and their families are aware that awards will be held in a separate area behind the restaurant, The Pantry (North of the competition floor)

Crazy Fan Section

Our crazy fan section will be available to friends and families who wish to watch their teams from the best viewing area on the day. Spectators will enter from behind the floor next to the banner. Make sure they look for the Crazy Fan Staff with your teams sign.

Transport

We recommend that you encourage your athletes and their families to use public transport to and from Manly Beach.

The best method of transport is to catch a bus or train to Circular Quay and then a ride on the scenic ferry across to Manly Wharf. It is then just a short walk along Manly Corso to the beach front.

Parking
