About Sindh Literature Festival (SLF)

Sindh Literature Festival (SLF) based in Karachi, Sindh, Pakistan is a literary event for the promotion of literature and supporting disciplines like languages, cultural assets and heritage, history, fine arts, music, education, performing art, archaeology and anthropology etc. The first ever three day festival was held from 4th to 6th November, 2016 at Beach Luxury Hotel Karachi. This festival provides innovative and high-profile events to support and showcase established, new and emerging writers and performers. As well as, offering the opportunity to attend the events and sessions to literature loving audience.

Full event is open and free, and bring together authors and writers in diverse languages and genres. They feature debates, discussions, talks, Urdu and Sindhi Mushairas, a book fair, book launches, readings, singings, satire, theatre, film screening, music and dance.

In SLF 2016, attendance was around 50,000 people, but the message was reached all over the world through more than 32 TV Channels and many of the newspapers including English, Urdu and Sindhi, which covered this event for all three days. In future number of attendance is expected to increase double. 35 sessions, 55 speakers, 35 moderators and more than 100 poets were part of the first Sindh Literature Festival.

Each year speakers will be exceptionally good, including keynote speakers. In SLF 2016, keynote speakers were Amar Jaleel, Hussain Haroon, Mohammad Hanif, Wusatullah Khan, Late Dr Hamida Khuhro, Sultana Siddiqi, Noor-ul-Huda Shah, Ali Qazi, Dr Suleman Shaikh, Syed Sardar Ali Shah, Aijaz Mangi, Qaiser Bangali, Jami Chandio, and Akash Ansari.

In upcoming festival beside the sessions, awards will be given to the different categories. Like literary excellence awards, literary prizes, publisher's award and life time achievement award. The SLF has the potential to serve as a catalyst to further promotion and celebration of Pakistan's many regional and vernacular languages.







Sindh Literature Festival 2016

The three day Sindh Literature Festival (SLF) was kicked off at the Beach Luxury Hotel, Karachi, on Friday 4th November, 2016. The Sufi singer Madam Abida Parveen formally opened the event by cutting the ribbon. It was followed by the recital of Shah Latif's verses from Sur Hussaini by the Faqirs who sing the Shah Jo Risalo every evening at Shah Latif's shrine. 




