TAX RULING tracked the leader in the opening mile, advanced along the inside through the backstretch to loom boldly entering the final turn, angled out for his bid on the final turn to take the advantage to the lane and held clear to the wire. SLIP AWAY quickened is pace after a half mile to take the lead, held the advantage to the final turn when bested by the winner after a brief duel then held place in a game effort. ARCADIUS settled well back while racing on the outside, offered his bid from that path nearing the final turn and improved steadily but was unable to reach place position before the wire. CHESS BOARD (GB) raced in the four path in the early and middle stages, advanced with a run near the half way point but had flattened out before being asked for a further rally. MIXED UP settled near the leaders racing on the inside, was in good position until the mid point then gave ground. CHIVITE (IRE) was close to the pace in the early stages, held good position to the last six furlongs but retreated from the challenge along the backstretch. TRIPLE DIP dwelt a bit at the start and trailed the field then pulled up. YOUR SUM MAN (IRE) raced near mid pack while in hand, tired nearing the mid point and pulled up shortly thereafter.
