Curriculum

I created a new BM-Composition curriculum to support both students interested in graduate study and those seeking immediate employment. New courses include jazz keyboard harmony, music technology, electronic media, interdisciplinary collaboration, entrepreneurship, world music, rehearsal techniques, and conducting.

Student Accomplishments:

SIUE offers only a BM in Composition. 100% of my undergraduates are accepted to graduate study, find immediate employment, or freelance and secure both conference and international performances. Graduate acceptances include UMKC, Bowling Green State University, Michigan State University, Indiana University, Butler University, and University of Oklahoma. * Two MM-Choral Conducting students took lessons with me, gave composition recitals, and were accepted directly to DMA-Composition programs.

Recruiting Examples

Assistant Department Chair for Publicity & Recruiting (Fall 2014-present)

I helped design and now coordinate five departmental committees: Print Advertising, Social Media, Public Outreach, University Website, and Data/Documentation.

- After my first year in this position, the Department's incoming class grew 60%.
- I redesigned Audition Days to include a Q&A session for parents, an academic orientation for students, a financial aid & housing counseling, a campus tour, and a theory placement diagnostic.
- I implemented an annual BBQ on the Saturday before fall classes to help build the student community and welcome new students to the department.
- I designed and maintain a website featuring an alumni spotlight, faculty blogs on pedagogy and musicianship, and student testimonials: <u>musicsiue.wordpress.com</u>.

Illinois Music Educators Association Composition Contest Workshop (Fall 2015)

• This is the first tenure-line faculty union at SIUE, certified by the Illinois Education Labor Relations Board in December 2016. Coordinator: Music Theory/Composition/Musicology Area (Fall 2012 to present)

• In Fall 2015 I led the department to implement a remedial theory curriculum in combination with a theory diagnostic on Audition Day. SIUE traditionally recruits a large number of jazz, guitar, and voices majors. While they are accomplished performers, many do not read music. This plan should alleviate the large disparity of abilities in Theory I, as well as some subsequent attrition problems.
