10. REGISTRATION FEE TO ADC

11. QUALIFICATION FOR THE WORLD CHAMPIOSNHIPS

For age categories Open Men and Women, International-100 draughts discipline's classic event championship will be the qualification tournament for the world championships of 2019. First two places in each championship will get the right to play at world championships in 2019. Qualifiers should be from different member

federations, therefore if first 2 players are from same country the next player will get the right until those qualified 2 players are not from same country.
