Description

The Bohle Transmitter Station site is a site of approximately 484 hectares, located 10 kilometres west of Townsville. The station is a communications facility used by Defence and forms part of the Modernised High Frequency Communications System, which includes a network of other similar sites around Australia.



Base Activities

Base activities are benign in terms of potentially contaminating activities; however there are three above ground diesel storage tanks located around the building compound.

Contamination Information

Known Contamination

No known contamination issues exist at the site.

Risk Assessment Rating

No identifiable risks have been found in environmental assessment works completed at the base.

Current Status

A Stage 1 Desktop assessment has been completed for the site. Stage 2 intrusive investigations to assess the quality of soil and groundwater around the above ground storage tanks has been recommended, but has not yet been completed.
