# PEPPERDINE HISTORY

Beginning its 69th season of intercollegiate play, the Pepperdine baseball program has long been known as one of the nation's finest.

Since fielding its initial team at the old campus in South-Central Los Angeles back in 1939, Pepperdine has established a baseball tradition that is rich in history. Pepperdine has compiled a cumulative record of 1,786-1,244-22 (.589) and has won 17 West Coast Conference championships. Additionally, the Waves have appeared in postseason play 27 times, including 24 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

The Pepperdine baseball program reached the pinnacle in June 1992 as the Waves captured the College World Series title for the first time in school history. Pepperdine defeated local rival Cal State Fullerton in the championship game by a final score of 3-2 in front of 17,000 fans at Rosenblatt Stadium in Omaha, Neb.

Former Pepperdine players who have enjoyed successful professional careers include Bill Bathe, Ryan Christianson, Mike Fetters, Gail Hopkins, Chad Krueter, Mark Lee, Keith McDonald, Rob Picciolo, Mike Scott (the 1996 National League Cy Young Award winner) and Andy Stankiewicz. Former Pepperdine players on 2008 Major League rosters include Dan Haren (Arizona Diamondbacks), Noah Lowry (San Francisco Giants), David Newhan (Houston Astros), Randy Wolf (San Diego Padres) and Matt Wise (New York Mets).

Pepperdine became an established collegiate baseball power in the 1950s under the guidance of head coach John Scolinos. The Waves advanced to the District 8 Playoffs in 1955, 1957 and 1960. The 1957 team was within one game of a College World Series berth before losing to eventual national champion California in Berkeley.

In the mid-1970s, Pepperdine won three consecutive WCC titles under the guidance of Wayne Wright, who later served as the University's Director of Athletics. The team competed in the District 8 Playoffs in 1974, 1975 and 1976.

Pepperdine advanced to the College World Series for the first time in 1979 under then-first-year head coach Dave Gorrie. After finishing second in the rugged Southern California Baseball Association, Pepperdine won the Mid-East Regional in East Lansing, Mich., defeating San Diego State in the title game by a final score of 13-2.

The Waves lost their opening game at the 1979 College World Series to Arkansas by a final score of 5-4, but rebounded to defeat Miami (9-4), Mississippi State (5-4) and Texas (6-4) before being eliminated by SCBA rival Cal State Fullerton by a final count of 8-5. Pepperdine finished third at the eight-team event and compiled a school-record total of 53 victories.

Pepperdine's success continued during the 1980s, as the team advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 1982, 1985, 1986, 1987, 1988 and 1989. The 1982, 1985, 1986 and 1988 teams advanced to their respective regional championship rounds only to be eliminated. The 1987 team established a school record by winning 21 consecutive games and was ranked as high as #2 in the national polls.

The WCC was reinstated for baseball prior to the 1984 campaign, and Pepperdine has been the league's dominant program, winning or sharing 14 of the 24 championships to date.

Pepperdine shook off years of frustration in 1992 as the team defeated Hawaii by a final score of 9-0 to win the NCAA West Regional at Tucson, Ariz. The Waves quickly became the crowd favorite at the 1992 College World Series, posting shutout wins over Wichita State (6-0) and Texas (7-0). After recording a dramatic come-from-behind 5-4 win over Texas, Pepperdine edged Cal State Fullerton, 3-2, in the first-ever NCAA championship game to feature two teams from the same state.

Pepperdine continued its success in the 1990s and compiled a 381-189-3 (.668) record during the decade. The winning percentage of .668 ranked 18th nationally among the winningest teams of the decade. The Waves capped off the decade by posting a 46-16 overall record and advancing to the championship game of the 1999 Los Angeles Regional at USC. Pepperdine finished the year with a Top 20 ranking and was ranked as high as #3 during the season.

The 2006 season marked a first in program history as Pepperdine was selected as a regional site and hosted its first-ever NCAA Regional. The Waves were seeded #1 in the regional and registered wins over Missouri and UCLA before eventually falling to the Tigers in the championship game.

Pepperdine made it 30 consecutive 30-win seasons in 2007 after registering a 35-22 overall record, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the fifth straight season.

In an all-California championship game, Pepperdine bested local rival Cal State Fullerton by the score of 3-2 to claim the 1992 College World Series at Rosenblatt Stadium in Omaha, Neb.

Under the direction of head coach Andy Lopez, Pepperdine advanced to the CWS after winning the NCAA West Regional Championship at Tucson, Ariz. The Waves quickly became a crowd favorite at Rosenblatt Stadium after opening CWS action with impressive shutout wins over Wichita State and Texas.

In order to advance to the championship game, Pepperdine needed to defeat Texas a second time. The Longhorns used a four-run rally in the top half of the seventh inning to take a 4-1 lead, but the advantage was short-lived, as Steve Rodriguez connected for a dramatic grand slam in the bottom half of the inning to propel the Waves to a 5-4 win. In the championship game, Patrick Ahearne, Derek Wallace and Steve Montgomery turned in solid efforts on the mound, and Eric Ekdahl's solo home run in the fifth inning proved to be the game-winning blow.

The 1992 team was inducted into the Pepperdine Hall of Fame in December 1999.

## 1979 PEPPERDINE BASEBALL FINISHES THIRD AT COLLEGE WORLD SERIES

Under first-year head coach Dave Gorrie, Pepperdine made its first-ever appearance at the College World Series and finished third.

After placing second in the rugged Southern California Baseball Association (SCBA), Pepperdine won the Mid-East Regional in East Lansing, Mich., defeating San Diego State in the title game by a final score of 13-2.

The Waves lost their opening game at the 1979 College World Series to Arkansas by a final score of 5-4, but rebounded to defeat Miami (9-3), Mississippi State (5-4, in 10 innings) and Texas (6-4) before being eliminated by SCBA rival Cal State Fullerton by a final count of 8-5.

Pepperdine finished third at the eight-team event, and compiled a school-record total of 53 victories.

The 1979 team was inducted into the Pepperdine Hall of Fame in December 1999.
