
Mission and Roles

SFAB Mission

In coordination with joint, interagency, and multinational forces, SFABs <u>develop</u> the <u>capacity and capability</u> of <u>foreign</u> <u>security forces</u> to facilitate the achievement of U.S. strategic objectives.



SFAB Roles

- Advise Teach, Coach, Advise
- Support Provide Capability
- Liaison Connect
- Assess Evaluate, Monitor, Report


An SFAB executes the generating and operating SFA function at the tactical level.






These formations are uniquely manned, equipped, organized, and trained to conduct tactical SFA within defined authorities to support unified land operations and build partner nation capacity and capability.

- Access to Joint Enablers
- Represents all War fighting Functions
- Equipped to operate independently
- Modular...Can expand and contract based on conditions
- Requires augmentation as threat increases




- Potential for more effective advising over time




