Eligibility


Tournament is open for all badminton players who are eligible to play for BWF Member Associations.

Condition of play

The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the Badminton Europe's Elite Circuit Regulations. Competitors must be prepared to play at the time determined for the events for which they have entered.

Events

Men's and women's singles, men's and women's doubles, and mixed doubles. The number of players/pairs to be accepted for the main single events is 32, for the main double events 24. The number of players in/from the qualification is subject to the final number of entries.

It is required that every event has at least 8 competitors. If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Entries

All entries must be made by using the BWF online entry system.

On-line entry link

Entries must be submitted not later than **Tuesday 12 December 2017 at 23:59 BWF HQ** time (GMT +08:00).

All participants need to have the BWF-ID http://bwfcorporate.com/players/entries/

No late entries will be accepted

Organizers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year.

Entry fee

Singles: 45€ per player

Doubles: 35€ per player/event.

Entry fees can also be paid in cash at the tournament venue before the first scheduled match. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.

The member association that enters a player into a circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. For all the players withdrawing in the time between the closing date and the beginning of the tournament the organizers invoice the entry fee to the relevant member association.

Draw

Draw will be made by Badminton Europe. World ranking date used for M&Q report – **14 December 2017** M&Q report release date - **15 December 2017** World ranking date used for seeding and draws – **21 December 2017 Draw date – 27 December 2017**

Withdrawals

Please ensure that the organizer will be informed immediately when a player has to withdraw, together with the reason for withdrawal. Any withdrawal after the Sunday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member



Association concerned liable to an amount of USD 150.00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal.

Last day of withdrawal without penalty – **24 December 2017**

Any player not showing up at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member Association concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show" (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).

Clothing and advertising

Advertising on clothing and color of clothing are regulated by BWF Competition Regulations 19 to 23 and BEC Elite Circuit Regulations 18. In applying these regulations the decision of the referee shall be final.
