S. War Department by the Brazos River Harbor Navigation District until such time as the two twelve inch pipe lines are removed from the bridge; after this the operation of the swing span is to be taken over by the State Highway Department; and on the further condition that suitable operating machinery and house for same will be installed by the Brazos River Harbor Navigation District when ifavigation requirements, in the opinion of the State Fighway Commission, makes same necessary, and after a properly executed agreement covering the above conditions has been filed. with the State Highway Department.

Moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Sterling, that not exceedin $\$ 10,000.00$ be appropriated for the improvement of Highway 429 in Caldwell County, from the present end of the black top road to the present pavem ment in the Town of Luling, such improvement to consist of adequate drainage structures and black maintenance top on gravel base, on condition that County furnish one-half of cost of said improvement. Conditioned further that Caldwell County agrees that when the Highway Depart|ment is ready to construct the road on new location that county will put up one-third of the cost of such improvement, including overpass, and furnish necessary right-of-way on new location. The State Highway Engineer shall proceed as soon as possible with phans and specifications for the construction of the road on the new location. A.F.E. $29-666$

Moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Sterling, that a designation be made from Lockhart to Martindale, in Caldwell County, on the most direct and practical route, and whereas the same practically covers the 01d San Antonio Road the same is intended to and is accepted by Caldwell County and its people as compliance with the act of the Legislature rem quiring the State Highway Comnission to open and maintain said road and on condition that the Commissioners' Court of Caldwell County will pass resolution to this effect.
