

International Social Survey Programme Ethical statement

The International Social Survey Programme is a collaborative large scale project with representatives from all over the world. The aim of this collaboration is to collect high quality comparative research data on issues of general sociopolitical interest. The ISSP source questionnaires are developed and pretested by international teams and discussed and approved by the ISSP General Assembly (GA), which is the main deliberative, decision making and representative organ of the ISSP. The GA approves questions based on their scientific merit, sociopolitical relevance and ethical appropriateness. ISSP members, the national field questionnaires and field work, all must comply with the given legal requirements in each country.

Before depositing data to the ISSP Archive national ISSP data are anonymized so that individual survey participants cannot be identified.
