PRESS RELEASE POETRY DOMINATES SAHITYA AKADEMI YUVA PURASKAR 2017

Sahitya Akademi announced its annual Yuva Puraskar in 24 languages today. Sixteen books of poetry, five of short stories, two of biography and one of essay have won the Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar 2017.

The Awards were recommended by distinguished Jury members representing 24 Indian languages and approved by the Executive Board of the Sahitya Akademi which met today under the Chairmanship of Prof. Vishwanath Prasad Tiwari, President, Sahitya Akademi.

Those who have won the Awards for their collection of poetry include Sri Pratim Baruah (Assamese), Sri Bijit Gwra Ramchiary (Bodo), Sri Rajinder Ranjha (Dogri), Sri Taro Sindik (Hindi), Ms. Nighat Sahiba (Kashmiri), Sri Amey Vishram Naik (Konkani), Sri Chandan Kumar Jha (Maithili), Sri. Kh. Krishnamohan Singha (Manipuri), Sri Saran Muskan (Nepali), Sri Suryasnata Tripathy (Odia), Sri Harman (Punjabi), Sri Hemchandra Belwal (Sanskrit), Ms. Maina Tudu (Santali), Ms. Rekha Sachdev Pohani (Sindhi), Ms. J. Jayabharathi (Manushi) (Tamil) and Ms. Mercy Margaret (Telugu). Sri Rahul Kosambi is awarded for his essay.

According to the procedure, the Executive Board declared the Awards on the basis of unanimous or selection made on the basis of majority vote made by the Jury. The Award relates to books published by an author of the age of 35 and below as on 1st January of the year of the award.

The Award in the form of a casket containing an engraved copper-plaque and a cheque of Rs.50,000/- will be presented to the awardees at a special function to be held at a later date.
