Bishan Public Library is well known for its architecture which captures the look and feel of a tree house with distinctive coloured pods.
Individual pods are cantilevered off the building's main facade and in the building atrium to create more private spaces by adding a touch of individuality within the library. They act as spaces for quiet reflection by individual users.
Artist Trading Cards (ATC) Club
The Artist Trading Cards Club meets once a month to create miniature works of art the size of playing cards. All forms of art can be used; the only requirement is that the cards should measure 2.5" by 3.5". Participants will learn how to create different types of ATCs and pick up tips on art.
Seniors' Chinese Reading Club
The club meets once a month for a 1.5 hours-long book discussion session in Mandarin. These sessions are facilitated by librarians, and the books discussed are mainly short stories/compilations, popular titles, or titles by local authors.
Adults' and Young People's Collection:
The Adults' Collection is found on Levels 2 and 3. There is a large variety of non-fiction books on different subjects, including Business, Finance, Health and Fitness, Cookery, Recreation and Travel Guides. Our collection of adult fiction can be found on Level 3.

	The Young People's Collection has materials suitable for teens from the ages of 13 to 19 and is located on Level 4. It bridges the gap for readers moving from the Children's collection to the Adult collection. Children's Collection: The Children's Collection has materials suitable for children from the ages of 0 to 12 and is located at the Basement. The collection includes children's magazines, books for babies, picture books for pre-schoolers,
