#### Summary

SHSV invited the Universities to the first Swiss University 3X3 Tournament at the Sport Center Polyterrasse. This new format is heavily promoted by FIBA – [www.3x3planet.com](http://www.3x3planet.com) – where they try to bring this new format to all corners of the world. SHSV decided to also try to start this movement on the university level.

The first edition didn't have the response we were hoping for. Ten men's teams and 3 women's teams found their way to Zürich on THU, May 12<sup>th</sup>. Apart from the official floor we could offer a great 3X3 experience with the official balls, 12 second shot clocks and experienced referees.

The tournament was played on one center court and two side courts, this gave enough possibilities to put together the schedule with time and space for the teams to also regenerate between the games.

The teams showed that this format is really attractive with lots of action and a fast paced game. The quality of play was good, especially in the semifinals and the final. Most of the players have never played a 3X3 tournament with those new rules and we had a lot of positive feedbacks.

Hopefully we find the possibility to have a second edition of this Swiss University 3X3 Tournament in 2017. At the moment we don't think that this will replace the 5vs5 tournament, but it gives another opportunity to bring student athletes together.
