## Polling Methodological note - 10 July 2018

The Kantar TNS Research Express Online Omnibus interviewed a representative sample of 1,086 adults in Great Britain between the $5^{\text {th }}$ and $9^{\text {th }}$ July 2018. All interviews were conducted as online self-completion. The Kantar TNS Research Express uses the Lightspeed access panel as its sample source.

The data was weighted to match population totals for age, gender, working status, 2017 General Election voting patterns, 2016 EU referendum voting patterns, education, region, and likelihood to vote in the next General Election. Further details on the weighting are given on page two.

## Voting intentions

The voting intention figures provided aim to show the current political opinion of the nation rather than to accurately predict the outcome of the next General Election.

## Change since our last poll

A change has been made to the voting intention questions: UKIP and the Green party are now shown on a second screen.

## Uncertainty

All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points.

Weights have been applied to the sample to ensure that it is representative of the general public in Great Britain aged 18+. The sources for the population totals are provided in each table.

## Likelihood to Vote in General Election

We have estimated the likelihood that each respondent will vote in the next General Election. This value is based on respondents' stated intention to vote, their age and whether they voted in the last general election. The expected population turnout has been included as a population total in the weighting matrix. This turnout has been estimated based on the relationship between sample and population turnout rates in the 2017 general election.
