Highlights

The eighth XP Presidential Poll (conducted after the dispute over the possible release of Lula during the weekend) shows an increase of former president's performance, within the margin of error.

Lula increased two points in the first-round scenario in which he's considered (28% to 30%). He rose also one point in the spontaneous scenario (12% to 13%), and Fernando Haddad, when the voters are informed that he's supported by Lula, increased one point as well (11% to 12%).

When Lula isn't considered, Jair Bolsonaro remains ahead. He rose one point in the spontaneous scenario (14% to 15%) and in scenario 2 (23% to 24%). These are the second and third consecutive weeks in which Bolsonaro increases one point in these scenarios.

On second-round scenarios, Bolsonaro loses to Lula (33% to 40%), and remains technically tied to Geraldo Alckmin (34% to 32%), Marina Silva (33% to 37%) and Ciro Gomes (33% to 31%).

Marina Silva voting intention also grew one p.p. in three of four first-round scenarios. In scenario 2, she is now five points ahead of Ciro Gomes. Two weeks ago, this difference was only one point.



Voting Intention - Spontaneous










Lula's Vote Migration














HOW DO YOU EVALUATE MICHEL TEMER'S GOVERNMENT SO FAR?



Timing of Choosing a Candidate




IN 2014, IN WHICH MOMENT HAVE YOU DECIDED WHO'D YOU VOTE FOR?






