PRO: The Titans signed Brice McCain as a free agent early in the 2016 offseason to add competition and experience to the cornerback position. The 5-foot-9-inch, 190-pounder is a veteran defensive back that has seen time outside and as a nickel corner during his seven NFL seasons. Prior to arriving in Tennessee, the University of Utah product spent his first five NFL campaigns as a member of the Houston Texans. McCain has also seen action with the Pittsburgh Steelers and the Miami Dolphins.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- In 2016, McCain tied for second on the team with 12 passes defended and two interceptions in his first season with the Titans.
- In 2015, McCain saw action in 14 games in his only season in Miami and tallied 39 tackles, one interception and 10 passes defended.
- In 2014, McCain played in 14 games for the Pittsburgh Steelers and registered a career-best three interceptions to go along with 25 tackles and six passes defended.

TITANS TIDBITS:

- In 2014, McCain played with the Pittsburgh Steelers and worked with current Titans defensive coordinator Dick LeBeau. McCain kept his notes from playing in LeBeau's defense and referenced them when making the transition to Tennessee.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS:

- The Terrell, Texas, native was originally selected by the Houston Texans in the sixth round (188th overall) of the 2009 NFL Draft.
- Re-signed by the Texans as an unrestricted free agent on March 20, 2013.
- Released by the Texans on March 11, 2014.
- Signed by the Pittsburgh Steelers as a free agent on April 1, 2014.
- Signed by the Miami Dolphins as an unrestricted free agent on March 11, 2015.
- Released by the Dolphins on Feb. 16, 2016.
- Signed by the Titans as a free agent on March 2, 2016.

SEASON RECAPS:

2017 (16/1, 2/0 - Tennessee): Played in all 16 games with one start at cornerback and registered 11 tackles, three passes defended and three special teams stops. Saw action as a reserve in both postseason contests. Led the team in passes defended once in 2017 (at ARZ). Tied for the team lead in special teams tackles once in 2017 (at HOU). Played in his 125th career regular season game against Cincinnati (11/12/17).

- Against Oakland (9/10), saw significant action as a reserve at cornerback and posted two tackles.
- At Jacksonville (9/17), played as a reserve at cornerback and collected a tackle.
- Against Seattle (9/24), saw action as a reserve at cornerback and notched a pass defended. Broke up a pass intended for Paul Richardson in the fourth quarter.
- At Houston (10/1), played as a reserve at cornerback and tallied a tackle. Tied for the team lead with a special teams tackle.
- At Miami (10/8), saw action as a reserve on special teams.
- Against Indianapolis (10/16), played as a reserve at cornerback and recorded a tackle. Notched a special teams tackle on coverage units.
- At Cleveland (10/22), saw action as a reserve at cornerback.
- Against Baltimore (11/5), played as a reserve at cornerback. Notched a special teams tackle on coverage units.
- Against Cincinnati (11/12), saw action as a reserve at cornerback in his 125th career regular season game and recorded a pass defended. Ended

a Bengals' drive by deflecting a third-and-four pass intended for Brandon LaFell in the third quarter.

- At Pittsburgh (11/16), played as a reserve at cornerback and notched a tackle.
- At Indianapolis (11/26), saw action as a reserve at cornerback.
- Against Houston (12/3), played as a reserve at cornerback and produced three tackles.
- At Arizona (12/10), saw action as a reserve at cornerback and tallied a tackle and a pass defended. Batted down a third-and-four pass intended for Jaron Brown in the fourth quarter.
- At San Francisco (12/17), played as a reserve at cornerback and posted a tackle.
- Against Los Angeles Rams (12/24), started at cornerback.
- Against Jacksonville (12/31), played as a reserve on special teams.
- At Kansas City (1/6), saw action as a reserve on special teams.
- At New England (1/13), played as a reserve on special teams.

2016 (16/10 - Tennessee): Played in all 16 games with 10 starts at cornerback in his first season with the Titans and tied for second on the team with 12 passes defended and two interceptions. Registered 44 tackles, including a stop for loss. Notched two special teams tackles. Led or tied for the team lead in passes defended twice in 2016 (at IND, at KC). Tied for the team lead in special teams tackles once in 2016 (vs. MIN).

- Against Minnesota (9/11), made his Titans debut as the nickel back and collected four tackles and a pass defended. Posted a special teams tackle on coverage units. Broke up a pass intended for Adam Thielen late in the second quarter.
- Against Oakland (9/25), started at nickelback and tallied two tackles and a pass defended. Broke up a deep pass intended for Seth Roberts in the third quarter.
- Against Indianapolis (10/23), saw significant action as a reserve at cornerback after Perrish Cox left the game in the second quarter with an injury and collected three tackles.
- Against Jacksonville (10/27), started at cornerback and posted two tackles and a pass defended. Broke up a pass intended for Allen Hurns early in the fourth quarter.
- Against Green Bay (11/13), started at nickelback and notched four tackles and an interception. Intercepted an Aaron Rodgers hail mary attempt on the final play of the first half and returned it 33 yards.
- At Indianapolis (11/20), played as a reserve at cornerback and recorded a tackle and two passes defended, including an interception. Forced the Colts to kick a field goal by defending a third-and-16 pass intended for T.Y. Hilton in the fourth quarter. Gave the Titans' offense the ball back by intercepting an Andrew Luck pass intended for T.Y. Hilton in the final stanza.
- At Chicago (11/27), started at nickelback and registered a tackle and two passes defended. Notched a special teams tackle on coverage units. Defended a pass intended for Deonte Thompson in the end zone late in the fourth quarter.
- Against Denver (12/11), started at cornerback and collected three tackles, a stop for loss and a pass defended. Combined with DaQuan Jones to stuff Justin Forsett for a two-yard loss on a rush off right tackle in the fourth quarter. Forced the Broncos to kick a field goal by breaking up a third-and-16 pass intended for Bennie Fowler late in the fourth quarter.
- At Kansas City (12/18), started at cornerback and tallied five tackles and two passes defended. Ended a Chiefs' drive by stopping Jeremy Maclin for no gain on a third-and-three pass in the second quarter. Batted down a pass intended for Travis Kelce in the second quarter. Knocked down a pass intended for Albert Wilson at the goal line in the third stanza.

2015 (14/11 - Miami): Played in 14 games with 11 starts and recorded 39 tackles, one interception and 10 passes defended. Was inactive for two contests.

- At Washington (9/13), made his Dolphins debut with six tackles and an interception in the season-opening victory.
- Against N.Y. Giants (12/14), registered a season-high six solo tackles and had one pass defended.
- Against Indianapolis (12/27), matched his season high with two passes defended.
- Against New England (1/3), participated in his 100th career game with a start, three tackles and one pass defended.

2014 (14/9, 1/1 - Pittsburgh): Played in 14 games with nine starts in his lone season with the Steelers. Notched 24 tackles, three interceptions returned for 56 yards, including one for a touchdown, six passes defended and a fumble recovery. Was inactive for one game and did not play in another contest.

- At Jacksonville (10/5), posted his first interception of the season and the sixth of his NFL career, which he returned 22 yards for a score, marking his second career interception returned for a touchdown.
- Against Baltimore (11/2), registered his first career fumble recovery.
- Against Cincinnati (12/28), notched two interceptions, the first multi-interception game of his career.
- Against Baltimore (1/3), started in the team's Wild Card game and collected six tackles in the contest.

2013 (16/4 - Houston): Played in all 16 games with four starts and recorded 28 tackles, one interception and seven passes defended. Added four special teams tackles.

- Against Jacksonville (11/24), made his first start of the season and tallied three solo tackles and one pass defended.
- At Tennessee (12/29), started and made five solo tackles and two passes defended.

2012 (12/2, 0/0 - Houston): Played in 12 contests with two starts and tallied 19 tackles, a half sack, one interception returned for a career-long 86 yards and eight passes defended. Also registered five special teams tackles. Placed on injured reserve - designated for return with a foot injury on Dec. 4, 2012. Missed the final four regular season games and both postseason contests.

- At N.Y. Jets (10/8), had two tackles, one interception and his first career half sack. Returned the interception 86 yards to set up a field goal.
- Against Baltimore (10/21), registered two tackles and two passes defended.

2011 (16/0, 2/1 - Houston): Played as a reserve in all 16 regular season games collected 25 tackles, two interceptions, one of which he returned for his first career touchdown, and 13 passes defended. Added three special teams tackles. Registered two or more passes defended in a game four times. Played in two playoff games with one start and posted two passes defended.

- At Tennessee (10/23), intercepted a Matt Hasselbeck pass and returned it 38 yards for his first career defensive touchdown. Also contributed three solo tackles and one pass defended.
- At Tampa Bay (11/13), intercepted a pass and returned it 10 yards to set-up a field goal. Also registered two passes defended.
- At Indianapolis (12/22), had a season-high seven tackles and registered two passes defended.
- Against Tennessee (1/1), registered a career-best three passes defended to go along with two solo tackles.
- Against Cincinnati (1/7), started in the AFC Wild Card game and registered two passes defended.

2010 (12/3 - Houston): Played in 12 games with three starts and notched 22 tackles and two passes defended. Was inactive for four games.

- Against Indianapolis (9/12), started and registered a season-high seven tackles.

2009 (16/1 - Houston): Played in all 16 games with one start at cornerback and tallied 11 tackles, one interception and three passes defended. Contributed four special teams tackles.

- Against Indianapolis (11/29), recorded his first career interception and first career pass defended.
- At Jacksonville (12/6), finished with a season-high five tackles.

- Against New England (1/3), made his first NFL start and registered a pass defended and on special teams tackle.

COLLEGE:

- Played in 49 games and made 39 starts in four seasons at Utah. Earned All-Mountain West Conference honors as a defensive back in 2007-08 and as a kick returner in 2006. Finished his career with 103 total tackles and his 21 career passes defended are tied for sixth in school history. Returned 37 kickoffs in his career for 847 yards.
- As a senior (2008), started all 13 games at cornerback and earned first-team all-conference honors. Finished the season with 35 tackles, five passes defended and one interception.
- As a junior (2007), started all 13 games and earned second-team All-MWC honors. Finished the season with 11 passes defended, which ranked third in the conference and is tied for fifth-best in a single-season in school history. Recorded 28 tackles, one interception and one forced fumble.
- As a sophomore (2006), played in 13 games and made 12 starts. Was a named honorable mention all-conference as a kick returner. Led the team with five passes defended and collected 28 tackles. Averaged 22.4 yards per kick return, which ranked fourth in the conference.
- As a freshman (2005), appeared in 10 games as a true freshman and made one start and notched 12 total tackles.
- Majored in economics at Utah.

PERSONAL:

- Graduate of Terrell (Texas) High School where he earned all-state and all-area honors. Named all-district as a running back and a defensive back and was named county and team MVP.
- Also lettered in basketball and track and was part of a 400-meter relay team that finished second in the state.
- Earned academic all-MWC honors.
