First attempt of Revival of the Delphic Idea in XX century



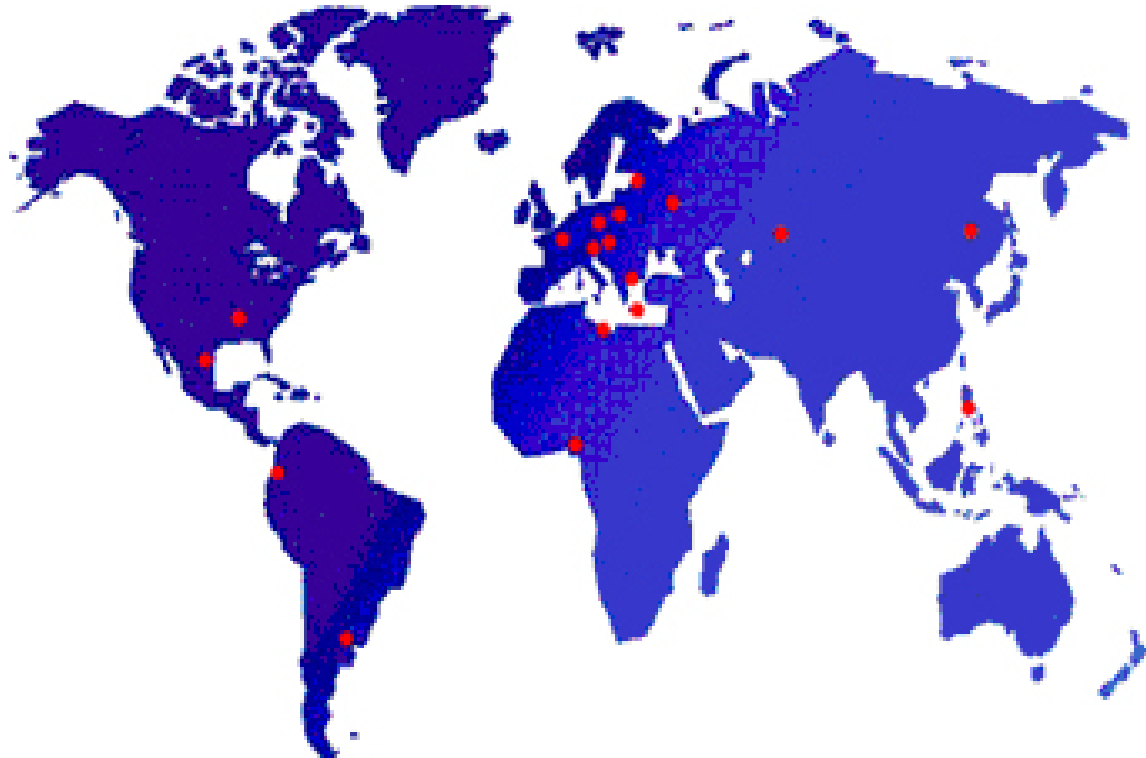
In 394 A.D. Theodosius I, the Emperor of Rome and Byzantium, banned the Olympic and Pythian Games as pagan.

1927 and 1930 two Delphic Festivals at the archeological site of Delphi, were organised by the Greek poet Angelos Sikelianos - against strong objections from the Greek government.



The International Delphic Council (IDC)

**100 years after the revival of the Olympic Games, with participation of representatives from 18 nations
5 continents
in 1994 was founded the International Delphic Council
in Berlin**

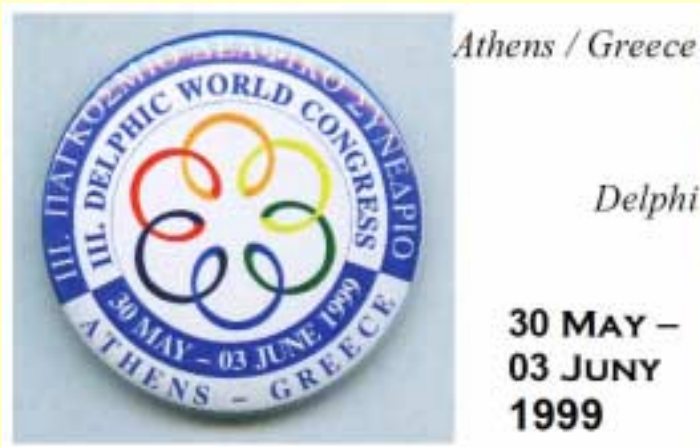
