CURRENT SITUATION						
Situation Summary:	Firefighters continued backfiring operations to improve containment lines. Mop-up and patrol efforts continued through the less active areas. Heavy timber and steep terrain are constant challenges for fire personnel. Fire spread is driven by the fuel and topography, with high potential for roll out, and spot fires. Islands of unburned vegetation inside the already burned area continue to produce significant smoke.
