## CURRENT SITUATION

<b>Situation Summary:</b>	Smoke over the fire area has moderated fire activity. Fire spread is primarily fuels and topography driven with potential for rollout and spot fires. Dense timber, dry vegetation, and terrain driven winds have challenged firefighting efforts. Firefighters continued to strengthen containment lines throughout the day and in less active areas of the fire mop-up efforts continued.
