



The Arizona chapter of Americans for Prosperity works to improve the well-being of Arizona citizens by passing legislative policy reforms that expand economic freedom. Our 2017 Legislative Scorecard is the 34<sup>th</sup> annual scorecard put out by AFP-Arizona and the Arizona Federation of Taxpayers. The Scorecard assigns weights to bills according to their projected dollar impact to Arizona taxpayers, consumers, and producers (\$1 million equals one point). Fiscal Year 2017-2018 budget was scored according to how many millions of dollars the Legislature and Governor voted to spend above or below \$9.9 billion — including supplemental spending increases to the FY 2016-2017 budget. Legislators are penalized on the Scorecard if key bills do not come to floor votes, but the Scorecard does allows for substitute bills that have similar policy impacts. The weighting of bills is adjusted for a probability factor and for a long-term policy value factor. AFP-Arizona traditionally assigns a triple weight to tax bills, using the Joint Legislative Budget Committee's three-year Fiscal Notes when available.
