

## **Copa Paulino Alcantara Cup Logo Contest Terms and conditions**

### **1. Introduction**

- A. The Liga Futbol Inc. ("LFI") the governing body of the Philippines Football League ("PFL") will introduce the Copa Paulino Alcantara Cup Competition from Season 2018 onwards.
- B. The inaugural Cup Competition is named Copa Paulino Alcantara to honor the Filipino football legend who is one of the all-time top scorers for European giants FC Barcelona.
- C. In conjunction with this inception, the LFI intends to create a logo. The logo will illustrate the identity and image of the Copa Paulino Alcantara Cup Competition and will be used in all printing and LFI official events of the Cup Competition.
- D. The creation of this logo is in line with LFI's mandate to develop football in the Philippines.
- E. This Copa Paulino Alcantara logo contest is managed by LFI in collaboration with the Philippine Football Federation.
- F. For the purpose of this contest the LFI is referred to as the "Organizer".

### **2. Objective**

- A. Create a logo of the Copa Paulino Alcantara to symbolize the national pride of Philippines football both locally and internationally.
- B. Provide opportunities for communities to take pride in the national football league.
- C. Official recognition and recognition to Filipinos to express ideas, creative and innovative ideas in creating the national cup competition.

### **3. Terms and Condition**

- A. Participation is free and open to all bona fide Filipino Citizens, who are acting in their own capacity and are above 18 years of age by the time of their submission of their entry.
- B. Participants can send as many entries as possible. However, only one logo will be selected as the winner.
- C. All logo designs must be original and not imitated and/or plagiarized from any local or international logos.
- D. The Organizer reserves the right to reject entries that are automatically generated by computer, illegible, copied, plagiarized and/or incomplete.
- E. All logos submitted to the Organizer shall be the property of the Organizer. Through the participation of this contest, all copyright work is assigned to the Organizer and the participants are deemed to have waived all rights associated to the logo submitted to the Organizer for this contest. The Organizer shall have the right over the selected logo and will



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have the authority to amend or modify for the purpose of use or print as Organizer's mark.

F. Participants must provide the following particulars when submitting entries:

- a) Full Name
- b) Government Issued ID
- c) Phone number
- d) Email Address
- e) Copy of Government Issued ID

G. By entering the contest, the participant confirms that he/she is lawfully eligible to enter such, as dictated by pertinent Philippine Laws. The Organizer may require the participant to show proof of eligibility at any time during the contest.

#### **4. How to enter**

- A. Participants must submit their entries via email, snail mail or by personally submitting their work to the LFI together with the entry form described below.
- B. An entry form, specified in Annex A of this document, must be submitted and signed together with the design. By signing the said form, the participant acknowledges that the design is:
  - i. An exclusive and personal work of the participant and does not incorporate any copyright or intellectual property right owned by another person or entity;
  - ii. Not defamatory, immoral, illegal in anyway;
  - iii. Not contrary to any kind of third party rights and/or agreements entered into by the participant.
- C. Soft copies of entries must be in a Photoshop Document (PSD) format and must include all pertinent files, links, fonts, images, and the like upon submission.
- D. All entries shall be submitted from 9 May 2018 until 31 May 2018.
- E. Receipts of entries will be acknowledged by the Organizer through email or through personal acceptance of the entry.
- F. Upon submission of the entry, the participant acknowledges that he/she hereby:
  - i. Assigns to the Organizer all his/her copyright and/or intellectual property rights over his/her entry with full title guarantee and;
  - ii. Waives all moral rights over his/her entry and/or otherwise arising in connection with the entry, to which he/she is or in any time in the future may be entitled to under the copyright, design, patent, and other pertinent laws and legislation in force anywhere in the world.





- G. The Organizer, its employees, and/or partners shall not be responsible for the non-receipt and/or non-acceptance of the entries in the contest as a result of lost, late, illegible, incomplete, invalid, or because of technical failures or otherwise, including such failures which is beyond the control of the Organizer, its employees, and/or partners.
- H. The Organizers, its employees, and/or partners shall not be responsible for any expense incurred by the participant in his/her effort to submit his/her entry.
- I. Participants are required to confirm in writing, as prescribed in paragraph 4B, that they have read, understood and complied with the terms and conditions of the contest and may be required to provide proof of eligibility as necessary and at the Organizer's discretion.
- J. Entries submitted to the Organizer cannot be returned.
- K. There is no purchase necessary to enter the contest and there is no charge for submitting an entry.

## 5. Winner selection

- A. Only one winner shall be selected from all the eligible entries received on the closing date of submission as indicated in paragraph 4D of this document.
- B. A panel of at five (5) judges shall be appointed based on their industry background. The panel shall select the winner and the decision shall be final.
- C. By participating, the participant acknowledges that they have read and agree to be bound by these terms, conditions, and the decisions of the Organizers and the panel of judges, which are deemed final in all matters relating to the contest.
- D. The winning entry may be subject to minor adjustments by the Organizer in order to ensure the practicality of use and to ensure that it is aligned with the overall branding of the tournament.
- E. The winner shall be notified by the Organizer through his/her contact details provided in his/her entry form. The Organizer shall, at all means, exhaust all efforts to contact the winning participant within one week from the announcement of winner. If the winner does not respond, despite the due diligence of the Organizer, the latter reserves the right to withdraw the prize entitlement and the prize will be forfeited in favor of the Organizer.
- F. The winning participant must meet with the Organizer once notified to supply the files of the winning entry on a date to be specified by the Organizer.
- G. The winning participant must hereby acknowledge that the Organizer may use his/her information for any reasonable or promotional purpose that may be deemed necessary.
- H. The winner may be required by the Organizer to appear for publicity and/or for any reasonable or promotional purpose.



- I. The names of the members of the panel of judges will be made available after the closing date of submission.
- J. The winner of the contest shall take necessary actions to ensure that the Organizer receives full benefits of the assignment of his design as described in paragraph 4F of this document.

## 6. Prize

- A. Only one winner will receive a prize money 50,000PHP tax free and shall be paid in full by the Organizer either through cash, check or bank transfer within 14 working days of the announcement of the winner.
- B. This prize money is non-transferable and shall not be claimed by a third party on behalf of the winning participant. Winning participant must exercise all means to claim his/her prize within the period specified above. The Organizer reserves its right to forfeit the prize in their favor if unclaimed.

## 7. Other conditions

- A. By entering the contest, the participant agrees to hold harmless the Organizer, its employees, and/or partners from any liability for any kind of loss, expense, or damage which is sustained or suffered, whether or not arising from any form of negligence, in connection to any kind of breach by the same.
- B. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel, modify, terminate, or suspend the contest without prior notice in the event of circumstances arising beyond its control.
- C. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any participant it finds, in its sole discretion, tampering with the operation of the contest or in breach of these terms and conditions.
- D. The Organizer, its employees, and/or partners shall not, in any way, be responsible to any participant and/or winner of the contest. Without prejudice to any foregoing or applicable law, neither the Organizer, its employees, nor its partners shall be liable for any loss, damage, personal injury, or death occurring as a result of the winner taking up his/her prize.
- E. These terms and conditions shall be governed and construed in accordance with applicable Philippine laws and statutes. Any kind of dispute arising in or in connection with the competition and its terms and conditions will be subject to the jurisdiction of Philippine courts.
