2018: Emily played two games at the China Exhibition and averaged 3.0 points per game and 2.5 rebounds per game. At the Japan Exhibition, Emily averaged 7.5 points per game and 1.0 assists per game.

2016: Made her Senior National Team debut in Spain, played in 1 game scored 7 points. Played 3 exhibition games in France. Member of the Development National Team and played 4 games in the Prague Open, averaging 18.7 minutes per game and 9.3 points. Played in 2 games at the Edmonton Grads exhibition with the Senior National Team.

2014: Member of the Development Women's National Team who placed 1st in the 35th Jones Cup, in Taipei Taiwan...averaged 20.7 minutes, 3.8 rebounds, 1.0 assist, and 11.4 points per game...3rd in the tournament for total 2-pts made.

2013: Member of the 2013 JWNT that competed at the FIBA U19 World Championships in Lithuania, finishing 7th.

2012: Member of the 2012 CWNT that competed at the FIBA U17 World Championships in Amsterdam where they won bronze...she finished 7th in the tournament for field goal percentage with 42.4%.

UNIVERSITY HIGHLIGHTS:

2017-18: Played in 32 games and 31... Averaged 25.7 minutes, 12.1 points, 7.3 rebounds and 0.7 assists per game... Pac-12 All-Conference and All-Defense Honorable Mention by the coaches... Pac-12 All-Academic Honorable Mention... CoSIDA Academic All-District Team... Broke the school record for career blocks with 270... First player in Utah's history to have 1500+ points, 900+ rebounds and 200+ blocks in their career... Leaves Utah ranked 5th in rebounds and Top-5 all time in Pac-12 history in career blocks.

2016-17: Played and started in all 31 games. Averaged 24.6 minutes, 13.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 0.8 assists per game.

Appeared in 33 games and started in all 33... averaged 26.8 minutes, 15.1 points, 10.2 rebounds, and 1 assist per game.

2014-15: Did not play due to injury.

2013-14: Appeared, and started in 31 games...averaged 25.5 minutes, 10.5 points, and 6.71 rebounds per game...Career high points of 18, twice, last against Stanford...Career high rebounds of 14, against Washington...Had 4 double-double, and six double-figure rebound performances.
