¹ A compromise agreement was reached on the African elephant, to allow sale of current ivory stockpiles from Botswana, Namibia, South Africa, and Zimbabwe, while instituting a moratorium on consideration of further ivory trade proposals from these countries for a period not less than nine years following the sale.



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
