
Original Cape Air route map Boston Provincetown







Cape Air's proposal includes a ramp-side inter-terminal shuttle, facilitating seamless connections between terminals at St. Louis, without having to re-clear security



#### **Key points**

- •24 weekly departures, the requested frequency, has historically been predicated on two round trips on weekend days, which are no longer off-peak times due to Cape Air's opening of EAS markets to leisure travelers due to the low fares.
- •Consistent daily service has proven time and again to generate a disproportionate amount of ridership
- •The incremental departures come at a discount, as fixed costs are covered
