#### Civil Service Commission, 21st July, 1953.

The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that, with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of H.M. Treasury, the following amendment has been made in the Regulations for the recruitment of Cartographical Draughtsmen dated 2nd June, 1953, and published in the London Gazette of the same date, viz.:—

*Regulation 1. Section II (Trained)*

delete "except that candidates for vacancies in the Directorate of Colonial Surveys must be at least 27 years of age on 1st January, 1953."
