Today's attendênce of 103,588 is a new record, breaking the old mark of 103,234 set against Michigan State in 1959.

Tim Killian's second quarter field goal establishes a new season record of six, breaking the old record held jointly by Killian (1968), Bob Timberlake (1964) and Rick Sygar (1965). Killian also holds the career record with 11.

Barry Fierson's punt return was his 20th of the season moving himinto a second place tie on the season list, tieing Faul Kromer in 1938. Lowell Ferry leads with 22 in 1951.

Tom Curtis today became the all-time national leader in yards returned with a three year total of 431 yards. The old record belonged to Michigan State's Lynn Chadnois (410). Curtis' interception total xxxx, second on the all-time charts, rose to 25.

Garvie Craws scored two touchdowns giving him a season total of 13 and the fourth highest number of touchdowns scored in a season. Ron Johnson had 19 last year, and Tom scored 16 in 1940 and 14 in 1939.

Jim Mardich ended his Michigan career in sec nd place among all-time Wolverine receivers in both number of catches with 111 and yordage 1415. Jack Clancy is the all-time leader with 132 for 1919.

Michigan now has won 16 of 1ts last 19 games.
