


Special design features make the Hunter 54 particularly strong and safe. An internal unidirectional glass frame both stiffens the hull and carries all major hull and rig loads, thus relieving the hull itself from major stresses. A special A-frame carries mast compression and also takes shroud loads via stainless-steel tie rods, and a special keel receiver is designed to absorb the shock of running aground. Auxiliary power comes from a four-cylinder diesel.


The Hunter 54 is truly a breakthrough in high-performance, offshore cruising. A product of three years of development and

thousands of offshore miles (including six transatlantic passages), she combines the performance of the finest custom grand-prix yachts with comfort, stability and ease of handling.





Perhaps the most important aspect of the 54 is that it is a Hunter — a true production yacht complete with CruisePac™, the most complete standard-equipment list available. This also means that the cost of a fully equipped Hunter 54 is substantially below similar boats with no standard equipment.

Standards include roller furling, on-deck anchor well and anchor roller, pedestal steering, and self-tailing winches. Below decks is an inviting entertainment area, comprising a spacious main salon with a stereo, twin dining tables, a complete galley with refrigeration system, and private staterooms fore and aft with individual heads and showers. There are two companion-ways with wet lockers for each, and unusually easy engine access via a removable galley unit.
