- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,041-281 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,114-340 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 13th in the series versus Syracuse, and the series now stands at 7-6 in favor of Duke.
- Duke had its nine-game winning streak snapped.
- The game was the first overtime game at Cameron Indoor Stadium since Feb. 18, 2015 a 92-90 win over North Carolina.
- Duke is now 69-59 all-time in overtime games.
- The game marked Duke's 243rd when playing as the AP No. 1-ranked team under Coach K, and Duke is now 211-32 in those games.
- All-time, Duke is now 234-37 when playing as the No. 1-ranked team.
- Duke is now 959-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 557-102 when playing as a ranked Top 5 team under Coach K.
- Duke had three different players record double-doubles in the game just the 25th time that's happened in Duke history, and the sixth time in the Coach K era.
- The last time three Blue Devils had double-doubles in the same game was February 7, 2002 versus Florida State.
- Duke blocked 12 shots in the game the seventh time this season the team has recorded 10+ blocked shots. That happened just three times over the previous seven seasons combined.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,037. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- The game was Duke's 447th consecutive sellout at Cameron Indoor Stadium, extending the longest streak in men's college basketball.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **Zion Williamson** set a single-game scoring record by a Duke freshman with 35 points. The previous record of 34 points was held by **J.J. Redick** (1/15/03 vs. Virginia) and **Marvin Bagley III** (11/24/17 vs. Texas).
- Williamson recorded his ninth double-double with 35 points and 10 rebounds, to go with four blocked shots.
- Freshman **RJ Barrett** had his second double-double with 23 points, a career-high 16 rebounds and was an assist shy of a triple-double with a career-high nine assists.
- Junior **Marques Bolden** recorded his first double-double this season and the second of his career with 12 points and 11 rebounds. He also blocked five shots.
- Sophomore Alex O'Connell scored a career-high 16 points, and had three rebounds, three assists and two steals.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** had two points, two assists and four steals in the game's first five minutes before suffering a game-ending shoulder injury.
- Junior **Javin DeLaurier** has made his last 19 field goal attempts, and is one shy of tying the all-time ACC record for consecutive field goals made (20) set by Duke's **Alaa Abdelnaby** in 1988-89.
