ARMS BADGES



- All Army vocationalists will wear their respective arms badge on the right collar.

EPAULETTES RANK

HEADRESS



- All service personnel will wear their respective coloured berets for No.4 Dress.
- Jockey Cap may be worn during training or by Recruit and NSmen, where beret is not available/issue.

FOREIGN BADGES

Formation Patch



- Highest precedence badge will be worn closest to the heart or above all other badges when more one badge is worn.
- Max of three badges may be worn on the right.
- Badges are worn centered and immediately above the top edge of the name tag.

SAF BADGES

1. State flag for overseas missions
2. Formation patch for local training



- Vocation or Highest precedence badge will be worn closest to the heart or above all other badges when more one badge is worn.
- Max of three badges may be worn above the Singapore tag.

- Name tag will be worn above the right chest pocket according to their Services' No.4 Dress.
- Max number of 11 characters (including spacing) for Officers and WOSpec on name tag.
- Max number of 17 characters (including rank and spacing) for Military Experts on name tag.

FOOT WEAR



Combat Boot Mid-cut Safety Boot Low-cut Safety Shoes

- Combat boot will be worn for all No.4 Dress, including Army, RSN and RSAF pixelised uniform.
- Combat boot with zipper will be worn for RSAF (Blue) No.4 Dress.
- Mid-cut Safety boot and Low-cut Safety shoes will be worn for RSN (Grey) No.4 Dress.

TAB AND PROFICIENCY BADGES



- Max of two tabs may be worn on the sleeve.
- Tabs are worn centered to the shoulder board, 1cm below the left shoulder seam.
- The second tab will be immediately below the first tab.
- IPPT badge will be worn 0.5 cm below and centred to the Marksmanship, Sniper Marksmanship or Fitness Specialist badge, if any.
- Where there is insufficient space, the position of the sleeve badges may be adjusted down such that the badge is at least 1 cm below the shoulder seam.

BELT



- A Green or black nylon belt with black buckle may be worn for Army and RSN/RSAF No.4 Dress respectively.

INNER SHIRT



- Inner shirt may be worn for No.4 Dress, except for parades.
- All service personnel will wear their respective coloured inner shirt.

SOCK



- Green and Black sock will be worn for Army and RSN/RSAF (Grey/Blue) No.4 Dress.
