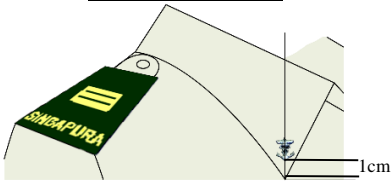

ARMS BADGES

FOREIGN BADGES

- Badges are worn centered, 3cm above the top edge of the right chest pocket or in line with the base of the SAF badges.
