### **Acas View**



"Our view is that one employer's red tape might be another's business certainty"...

Acas Council response to the Red Tape Challenge into the Equality Act - July 2012

## **Environment**



- Only regulate when there is no non-regulatory alternative
- Only regulate where such an approach is superior by a clear margin
- Only regulate where it can be achieved proportionately accountably transparently and targeted
- Presumption of no additional costs through regulation and OIOO approach
- Sunset clauses after 7 years

## Regulation



### **Regulations:**

 Currently a limited right to ask for parents and certain carers, but highly prescriptive in handling –

Meeting within 28 days
Decision within 14 days of meeting
If rejection tell employee of 14 days appeal
Hear appeal in 14 days of appeal request
Notify with 14 days of final decision

 And all this for parents of children under 18 and certain carers (married or CP; a relative or neither but lives with you)

## Code on Right to request Flexible Working



- Pushing at open door?
- Principles based to act in a reasonable manner creates flexibility and is deregulatory
- Good practice guide for business confidence to take action

Learning from the Nat Cen evaluation of the D&G code June 11 found that understanding was crucial (of principles )to small businesses taking action

## **A Good Approach**



#### First cut analysis from public consultation asks for:

- Guidance on how to say no
- Guidance on avoiding discrimination
- Guidance on being fair

But almost all welcomed the principles and almost all said give us examples of how to do it!

## Authoritative guidance to replace 3 section 138



#### **Red Tape**

- Removal of procedural elements and replaced by a common need to exchange information to settle or resolve case
- A risk to access to justice?
- Involvement

## **A Conclusion for Guidance**



#### **Non-Regulatory Alternative:**

- The importance of involvement
- The importance of the messenger (effectively the Acas Council)
- Supported by practical examples of how to do things

Both rely on a strong relationship between the social partners and a willingness of stakeholder groups and individuals to contribute in time and resources
