BILL DESCRIPTIONS AND VOTES

STATE PARKS

- 1. HB 698 Stopping of Land Purchases for State Parks: House Bill 698 would effectively stop any significant expansion of existing parks or the creation of new parks. It would bar most land purchases (and improvements to donated lands) until all current state parks are "properly maintained, brought up to date and in good working order", a nearly impossible standard to meet. Passed in the House by a vote of 85 to 62 on April 13, 2017. OPPOSE
- 2. <u>HA 1 to HCS SCS SB 22 Selling Off of Public Lands:</u> This vote was to remove from SB 22 language mandating the sale of four new State Parks. They are the Eleven Point, Jay Nixon, Ozark Mountain and Bryant Creek State Parks. *Failed in the House by a vote of 60 to 83 on May 12, 2017.* **SUPPORT**

FACTORY FARMS

- **3.** HB 175 Taking Away Local Control for Pollution Ordinances: This bill would prohibit counties from regulating the disposal of waste from factory farms to prevent the pollution of streams and waterways, as well as neighboring public and private property. *Passed in the House by a vote of 111 to 43 on March 27, 2017.* **OPPOSE**
- **4. HB 1614 and SB 627 & 925 Attacks Local Control for Community Protection from Factory Farms:** HB 1614 decreases the ability of counties and municipalities in Missouri to enact ordinances to protect property rights, water and health from the hundreds of millions of gallons of feces waste generated by corporate factory farms. SB 627 & 925 is an omnibus bill with the language of HB 1614 included. SB 627 & 925 was approved by the Senate on third read on March 8, 2018 with a 24 to 7 vote. HB 1614 was approved by the House on third read on March 8, 2018 with a 109 to 39 vote. **OPPOSE**

CLIMATE CHANGE

- **5.** HR 12 Support for Scott Pruitt for EPA Chief: Urges the United States Senate to confirm Scott Pruitt as the head of the EPA. Pruitt is a climate change denier and supporter of extreme fossil fuel extraction techniques. *Passed in House on February 6, 2017 by a vote of 110 to 44.* **OPPOSE**
- **6.** HA 6 to HCB 16 Missouri's Adherence to the Paris Climate

 Accord: Would require the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to take action to have Missouri adhere to the terms of the Paris Climate

 Accord to reduce carbon pollution. Rejected by the House by a 34 to 96 vote on March 24, 2018. **SUPPORT**

UTILITY POLICY

7. SS #5 SB 564 – Weakens Public Service Commission: This bill weakens the Public Service Commission's oversight of monopoly utilities in a way which disincentivizes energy conservation and allows unfair rate increases for ordinary residential ratepayers. *Passed the Senate on third read on February 15, 2018 by a vote of 25 to 6. Truly Agreed and Finally Passed in House on May 16, 2018 by a vote of 125 to 20. OPPOSE*

8. <u>HB 340 - Fee for Solar Users</u>: Would allow utilities to charge a fixed monthly fee for customers who have solar panels hooked to the grid. The fee can be up to 75% over normal monthly utility bill fixed fees. *Passed in the House on April 3, 2017 by a vote of 102 to 51.* **OPPOSE**

NUCLEAR WASTE

9. SB 22 - Confronting Missouri's Nuclear Waste Crisis: Would authorize a state buyout of homes near the radioactive Westlake Landfill. The Sierra Club supported the original bill which passed the Senate on April 12, 2017 by a vote of 30 to 3. SUPPORT

LABOR RIGHTS

10. <u>SS2 SB 19 – So Called "Right to Work"</u>: The Sierra Club supports labor rights. This bill takes away the right of unions to have a closed shop where those who benefit from collective bargaining pay their fair share to the union. Senate Substitute #2 Senate Bill 19 passed the Senate on January 25, 2017 by a vote of 21 to 12. It passed the House on February 2, 2017 by a vote of 100 to 59. **OPPOSE**

REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS

11. HCS SS SB 5 – Attack on Reproductive Rights: This bill puts up additional barriers for women to obtain reproductive health services. It makes it harder for legitimate reproductive health centers to operate while making it more difficult for municipalities to regulate entities that give misleading and false information on reproductive health. This was the focus of the second 2017 Special Legislative Session. Third read and passed in the House on June 20, 2017 by a vote of 110 to 38. Passed in the Senate on July 25, 2017 by a vote of 22 to 9. **OPPOSE**

WATER

- **12.** Approval of Clean Water Commissioner Hurst: Governor Greitens' recess appointee to the Clean Water Commission John Hurst opposes strong water quality standards for lakes. Upon appointment, before confirmation, he voted to approve the permitting of two factory farms opposed by many in the surrounding community out of concerns for water quality and supply. These permits were previously rejected by the Commission. Approved by the Senate on January 31, 2018 with a 22 to 10 vote. **OPPOSE**
- 13. HCS SCS SB 917 Weakens Coal Ash Protections: Weakens DNR oversight of toxic coal ash and prohibits any state regulation of City Utilities of Springfield's existing or proposed coal ash landfill that would be more protective than federal regulation. Approved on third read and passed in the House on April 30, 2018 by a vote of 107 to 37. It was third read and passed in the Senate by a vote of 25 to 8 on May 3, 2018. OPPOSE
- 14. HCS #2 HB 1973 and HCS SS SCS SB 782 Weaken Missouri Clean Water Law: HCS # 2 HB 1973 weakens the Missouri Clean Water Law by exempting agricultural runoff pollution from the same standard of scrutiny as other sources of pollution. The language of this bill was added to HCS SS SCS SB 782. HB 1973 was third read and passed in the House on April 5, 2018 by a vote of 105 to 38. HCS SS SCS SB 782 was third read and passed in the Senate on May 3, 2018 by a vote of 21 to 11. **OPPOSE**

METHODOLOGY

In cases in which the legislator had not yet been sworn in, had died, or resigned, the vote was labeled "not in house or senate" and was not included in the calculation.
