

Outline Description The date when the chapel was built is not known. However from pastoral visits, dating to 1600, by Bishop Gargallo states that the chapel was being built anew.

Property Description
Although the chapel falls under the dedication of the Assumption of the Madonna, it is locally known as "tal-Indirizz". The façade of the chapel is simple. The west front of the chapel is bare from architectural decoration. Indeed it is pierced by an arched door with two elegant pilasters flanking either side of the door and capped with a capital. Resting on the capitals, there is a rectangular cornice with an entablature containing square motifs. Directly above the doorway, there is a small round window that illuminates the tiny interior. The façade terminates with a slanting roof and a pedestal with a Cross. On the left hand side of the chapel there is a square bell tower housing four small bells.
