This program puts a focus on professional work experience. In addition to the academic work, **professional experience of 12 months** is required for graduation. At least 3 months thereof are completed in France or in a francophone country. Prior professional experience may count towards this requirement; the approval is administered by ESSEC.

At the time of the double degree application deadline, at least six months of full-time practical experience needs to be proven.

Upon successful completion, you will be awarded with the **'Master in Management M.Sc.'** by the University of Mannheim and the **'Master in Management'** of ESSEC Business School.

STUDY PLAN

In general, double degree students take all course work required to obtain both degrees without extending the standard study period of four semesters. Therefore, please make sure to plan your course of studies thoroughly as early as possible (according to the plan below).

You will spend the first and second semester in Mannheim, where you will take the five core courses of the MMM, as well as well as electives and a research seminar (7xx module) in order to





fulfill the requirements for writing your master thesis. Details can be found in the MMM module catalog.

During the third and fourth semester you will study at ESSEC with course work worth at least 60 ECTS, including both core courses and electives.
