Property Description

Originally dedicated to St John the Baptist, the chapel became popularly known as dedicated to the Madonna of the Light, due to its titular painting depicting the Madonna, installed in 1737. The chapel was rebuilt in 1758. It has an arched doorway with an oval oculum above it. It has a small exterior belfry with S-scrolls topped by a triangular pediment with a cross on the pinnacle. The chapel has a painting of St Francis de Paule by Francesco Zahra. The titular painting is flanked by two smaller paintings of St Joseph and the Madonna respectively. There are also a number of exvoto.


