was FSU's Athletics Director from 1979 to 1993. During his tenure at Ferris, Davenport led the Bulldog athletics department to the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference President's Cup 12 consecutive years.

Davenport was instrumental in the planning of the FSU Sports Complex, the growth of women's intercollegiate athletics, the emergence of Ferris' NCAA Division I men's ice hockey program and the development of the athletics scholarship program.

A graduate of Central Michigan, Davenport was Ferris' acting director of the health, physical education and recreation division from 1977 to 1979

when he was appointed director of athletics. He also was an assistant men's basketball coach and coordinator of athletics at FSU prior to his appointment as athletics director.

While at Ferris, Davenport was a leader in the NCAA, serving on the nominating and men's sports committees. He also held positions on the honors, basketball rating and scholarship committees. Davenport served as president of the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, the Midwest Intercollegiate Football Conference and the GLIAC.

A basketball letterwinner at CMU, Davenport was the athletic director and head basketball coach at Iowa Wesleyan College before coming to Ferris in 1970. He has also held coaching stints at Traverse City, Petoskey and Grant High Schools in Michigan and was an assistant men's basketball coach at both Central Michigan and California State Northridge.

Davenport and his wife, Joyce, reside in Big Rapids.

THE FERRIS STATE "BULLDOG"

The "Bulldogs" have been Ferris State University's official mascot since 1930, when the name was applied to the Ferris Institute basketball team.

At the time, an unknown sportswriter became impressed by the way coach Bill McElwain's chargers were winning close games with defense teven recording a shutout once). He described the stingy defense as "hanging on like a bulldog." During an eight-game winning streak for the 1930 squad, Ferris held the opposition to an average of 17.1 points per game. Then he began referring to the team as the "Bulldogs." The nickname stuck and has been used ever since.

The logo was re-designed in 1979 by former FSU graphic artist Terry Davenport, son of former Bulldog Athletics Director Dean Davenport
