Lawrence Kohlberg → 6 Stages → 3 levels

Stage 1: Punishment Orientation: Actions are evaluated in terms of possible punishments, not goodness/badness; obedience to power is emphasized

Stage 2: Pleasure-seeking orientation: Proper action is determined by own needs.
