Hae Min Lee is a Full Time Student at Woodlawn HS and works part-time at Lenscrafters in Owings Mill Mall. She is a KOREAN CITIZEN with a Green Card. The Korean Embassy has been notified of her disappearance.

Hae Min Lee is currently listed as a missing person with Baltimore County Police Department. The officer in charge of the Investigation is Det. Sgt. Joe O'Shea, Homicide and Missing Persons Department - Telephone Number and Voice Mail: [REDACTED] Mandy [REDACTED] has established a good rapport with Det. Sgt. O'Shea and there has been daily telephone contact between them. The Case Number is : 99113174 The original report was generated by Officer Adcock.

The following known information has been given to Detective Sgt. O'Shea by Mandy [REDACTED] and has been freely discussed with him.

Several years ago Hae Lee enjoyed a vacation to Florida, she stayed with her mother at [REDACTED], Deland, Florida. It is conceivable that she might return there if she was unhappy or under stress or pressure.

It is possible that her father has re-entered the United States and may be residing in California. Hae Lee has other relatives in California. Her relatives here in Maryland do not know if her father has entered the country illegally and might have contacted Hae Lee. They have informed relatives residing in California of Hae Lee's disappearance. To the best of their knowledge and belief her father is not in the continental United States. Hae Min Lee has not picked up her last Lenscrafters paycheck.

Hae Min Lee has left behind her Korean Passport and Diary.

She may be in possession of one credit card belonging to her mother, as well as one credit card of her own, which is at a maximum balance and no longer useable.

Hae Lee is computer literate and has an Email account on America Online. She possibly also has another account on NetCom. She is cognizant enough to have made calls to Network and Internet Service Providers. These calls may have been made for purpose of Network Communications login or for modem technical support. This information is based on the following phone numbers found on her uncle's telephone bill.

Hae Min Lee is known to participate on Asian Internet chat lines.
Her AOL screen name is [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]@aol.com)
Her AOL User Profile, checked on 1/16/99, read as follows;

Interests: Movies, Phone, Partying, TV, Music and most importantly Don.
Likes: Looking in his blue gray eyes, fast cars like his Camaro, driving to BelAir, Selling glasses and her beauty, spending as much time as possible in the lab. Occupation: Part-time sales, Full-time Girlfriend. She ends with "I love you and I miss you Donnie. Gives Astrological Sign as: Libra.

Friends:

Adnan Syed: Student at Woodlawn High School. Muslim. (Sect unknown)
Ethnic Background: Unknown. Known to be religious. Her diary states "His religion is his life's driving force" He has risked parental disapproval by dating a non-Muslim girl. He is known to be possessive and domineering but not necessarily violent. It has been said that he smoked marijuana when in crisis after a friend died suddenly in an accident, but he does not seem to be a habitual drug user. He is athletic, good student and was Prom Prince as a high school junior in 1998. According to Det. O'Shea he did not know Hae Lee was dating Don [REDACTED]. Syed's parents were upset about the police interview taking place.

Donald [REDACTED]: Co-worker and new boyfriend. Contacted both by police and by Mandy [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] appeared mature, articulate but not overly concerned. Although helpful and polite he did not sound in any way emotionally concerned with Hae Lee's disappearance. He felt she had gone to California to be with her father. But he did state that he hoped she would contact him. He did say that she had a girlfriend whose parents were away on vacation for the week (ending 1/16). He did not know who it was but offered the information "just in case".

Aisha [REDACTED]: Black Female, also student at Woodlawn High School. Probably Hae Min's best friend. Nothing unusual reported in Hae Min's diary. [REDACTED] seems to be a good student who was concerned about Hae Lee's preoccupation with Adnan Syed. Their friendship was not as close after Hae Lee began dating him.

Tori [REDACTED] and Marie [REDACTED] are two other fellow students and friends from school.

General Information:

Family and police have mentioned that Hae Min planned to go on a trip to France sponsored by her French class, that would cost approx. \$2,500 - 3,000. There is no indication in ^{diary} ~~diary~~ of particular interest or plans.

Family have also mentioned a close relationship with a teacher involved with the trip. No notation of this person in the diary.

School friends say Hae Min claimed to have access to \$3,000.

All known telephone numbers of friends have been given to Det. Sgt. Shea by Mandy [REDACTED]

Detective Sgt. O'Shea and Det. Park, who speaks Korean, will contact the Kim family and arrange to meet with them during the first week of February, after which the media will be alerted. Det. O'Shea will contact Mandy [REDACTED] with updates.

Several local police jurisdictions have been notified of Hae Lee's disappearance by Mandy [REDACTED]. Local and National APB's have been posted by Baltimore County, Baltimore City and Maryland State Police Departments.

Northwest Airline reservations for 24 hours after Hae Lee's disappearance have been accessed but provided no leads. BWI Satellite parking lot has been informally checked.

Further Action:

Long-distance truck drivers at Port of Baltimore will be notified by Mandy [REDACTED] during the first week of February in order that missing person posters can be posted at rest stops into and out of Maryland and DelMarVa regions

Korean Community members and religious centers throughout the region are being notified by Mandy [REDACTED].

Hae Lee's diary is being analyzed. A copy has been made and is retained by The Enehey Group. The original will be returned to her family to be given to the Police Department to aid them in their investigation.

The Enehey Group will prepare a profile on Hae Lee Min for review and analysis. Consultants [REDACTED].

Asian Chat Lines will be randomly monitored by Enehey computer consultants.

Summary:

The following information has been provided by Det. Sgt. O'Shea;

Hae Min Lee was last seen in the Gym at Woodlawn High School in Baltimore County on Wednesday, January 13th, 1999 at approximately 3 PM by her friend, Debbie [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] claims Hae Min told her that she was going to pick up her niece at a nearby kindergarten. Ms. [REDACTED] states that Hae Min was alone at that time.

At 2.15 PM. Hae Min was seen by Mr. Adnan Syed, a boyfriend, as well as a girlfriend, Aisha [REDACTED] in class. All friends note that Hae Min was in good spirits and did not appear angry or depressed.

Hae Min did not pick up her niece at Canfield Kindergarten nor did she report for work at Lenscrafters. When the kindergarten staff called Hae Min's uncle, [REDACTED] Kim, to notify him that his daughter was still with them and that his niece had not yet picked her up. Subsequent attempts to locate Hae Min Lee were made and the police were called at approximately 5 PM

A missing persons report was taken by Office Adcock at 5.15 PM. Mandy [REDACTED], Director of the Enehey Group, spoke with Hae Lee's colleague at Lenscrafters, Donald R. [REDACTED]. Hae Lee had recently begun dating Mr. [REDACTED] and she seemed very enthusiastic about their relationship. He stated that they had gone out together the night before her disappearance January 12th, 1999. He confirmed that this was the last time he saw her. He said that he called her later to assure she had arrived home safely. During the date, he claims she told him that she'd had an argument with her mother earlier that day and that she had expressed the desire to live with her father in California. When asked how she would accomplish this, Mr. [REDACTED] seemed to think she would either drive there or leave her car in the Satellite Parking Facility at BWI Airport and fly by commercial airline to California. He did not appear as enthused about their relationship as Hae Lee's diary indicates that she was.
