

Thanks to a growing interest in the South Island's outdoor winter sports activities – both from domestic travellers and those overseas – June has become a popular time to visit Christchurch and the wider Canterbury region. Despite the city experiencing it's wettest and darkest June on record, the celebration of Ramadan did help to boost international arrivals from places like Indonesia and Malaysia.



INDONESIA

Ramadan celebrations increased the number of Indonesian travellers arriving in Canterbury this June quite significantly, while Malaysian visitor numbers also saw a boost.
