### 1) NEW FAST-TRACK FUNDING CHANNEL FOR IPCC-DRIVEN MEETINGS

At the recent PAGES Scientific Steering Committee (SSC) meeting in Nagoya, Japan (7-8 June 2010), the importance of 2k synthesis products for the upcoming IPCC AR5 was discussed with the result that the 2k groups are encouraged to push ahead with producing a first synthesis in time for AR5 (details under (2)).

To support this effort (and other urgent efforts) efficiently, PAGES SSC has decided to provide a "Fast-Track" workshop proposal option, which will enable urgent support decisions to be made between the usual biannual proposal deadlines.

### 2) ANTICIPATED 2k NETWORK PRODUCTS

#### PAGES 2k synthesis book and meeting:

As decided during the Corvallis 2009 workshop, PAGES plans to produce a book (or a large special issue of a journal, or a combination of both) documenting the results of the global 2k Network. Considering that several groups only just started their activities with regional workshops, the timing towards this synthesis book aims for publication in 2014. To initiate the writing process a PAGES 2k Network synthesis meeting is planned for 2013.

# PAGES 2k contribution to IPCC AR5 (best temperature reconstructions):

At the Corvallis 2009 workshop it was decided to not push for extensive contributions for the IPCC AR5. However, coordinating lead authors from chapter 5 of IPCC AR5 ("paleoclimate archives") invited the 2k groups to publish first important results prior to the final synthesis. A suggestion is that all regional 2k teams contribute with a best temperature reconstruction of their area. This can be a time series (or a set of time series for different regions) or even a spatial reconstruction. However, it is acknowledged that several groups might not be able to present a reconstruction for the whole 2000 year period. We suggest publishing these time series in a joint article in a highly ranked scientific journal. Similar to EPICA, all co-authors would be listed under the heading "2k consortium".

#### PAGES newsletter issue:

PAGES would love to publicize the 2k activities in the newsletter and offers to produce a special issue centered on a summarizing contribution from each regional group. This option and its timeframe will be discussed at the next 2k network meeting in Bern in July 2011.

PAGES will try to organize limited travel funds for the Working Groups and will provide more information on how to apply for individual financial support in the next 2k Circular.

#### Activities:

The 1<sup>st</sup> Asia2k Workshop was held in Nagoya (26-27 August 2010). It was the first opportunity to review, correlate and synthesize all individual proxybased findings (tree ring, stalagmite, coral ring, sediment, ice core, historical documents etc.) in the Asian region and surrounding ocean for the past two thousand years. The Workshop Report will be published in the next issue of PAGES news.

There are also plans for a PAGES Asia2k training workshop in 2011. Participants will be encouraged to bring their data and contribute to a product that will subsequently be published in a journal.

#### Activities:

The first Aus2k regional workshop "towards data synthesis" was held in Melbourne, Australia from May 31 to June 2, 2010. The goal of this meeting was to evaluate existing and develop new annual to decadal 2K climate reconstructions from Australasia. An Aus2k metadatabase hosted on the PAGES Aus2k website has been set up and will shortly be populated with records.

A proposal has been approved by the Australian government to fund a postdoc for the Aus2k effort.

The second Aus2k workshop will take place on April 26-28, 2011 in Perth, Australia. This workshop will focus on the generation of reconstructions of different climate variables for the Australian region and identify caveats in the reconstructions of the full 2k period.


#### Activities:

#### Activities:

Two synthesis papers by Neukom et al. (2010) presented synopsis of spatial and temporal temperature and precipitation fields in southern South America.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> International Symposium "Reconstructing Climate Variations in South

America and the Antarctic Peninsula over the last 2000 years" took place in Valdivia, Chile, 27-30 Oct 2010. This is a follow-up conference of the Malargue PAGES conference of 2006 in Argentina. The goal of the meeting was to bring together scientists from different paleoclimatic fields, to review and discuss current knowledge and search for calibration and quantification techniques of proxy dataset in South America and the Antarctic Peninsula.

This conference was preceded by a five-day educational meeting; "South American Climatology and Quantitative High-Resolution Climate Reconstructions in Paleoecology (23-27 Oct 2010, Valdivia, Chile)". The main objective of this course was to facilitate knowledge transfer from experienced to young researchers and between national researchers.
