### About the study

  - How many of the top companies worldwide have a CDO, who are these CDOs and how do they fit
    in the organization
  - Draws on a combination of global data based on desk research and CDO interviews from various industries

## The 2016 CDO study

- This year's edition of the study analyzes CDOs at the top 2,500 public companies worldwide
- The deep-dive topic acknowledges the fact that the nature and brief of CDOs vary depending on the
  companies' digital ambition and goals. It looks into how the CDO who gets appointed fits into the
  company's digital ambitions and how they're embedded in the organization to carry those
  ambitions out

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#### Summary of research results

- 19% of all companies have a CDO in place
- 38% of companies in EMEA and 23% of companies in North America have a CDO
- Companies in the financial services and consumer-focused industries have the highest CDO ratio
- The largest companies have the highest CDO ratio (33%)
- 60% of all CDOs identified were hired during 2016 and 2015
- Relatively speaking, Utilities and financial institutions put the most CDOs in place during 2016 and 2015
- 40% of CDOs are C-level members
- **Leading backgrounds** of CDOs are "Marketing, Sales and Customer Service" with 39% and **Technology** with **32%**
- 52% have been recruited internally, 46% are external hires
- 10 16% of C-Suite CDOs are female, 84% are male

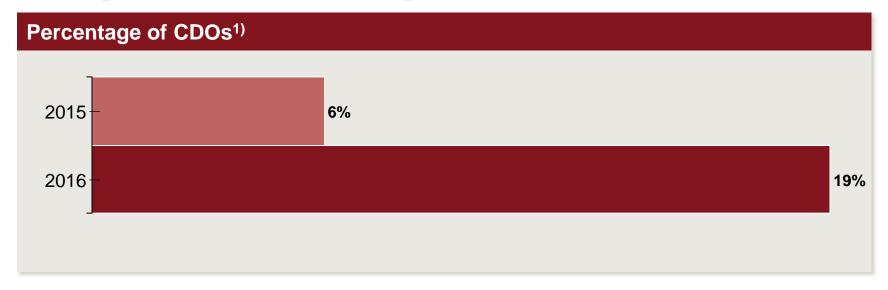
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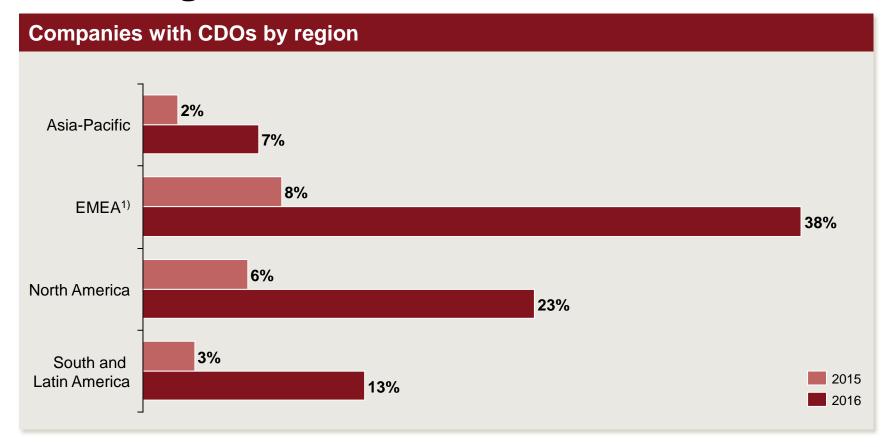
### 1 The Chief Digital Officer role remains on the rise: 19% of all companies have a CDO in place



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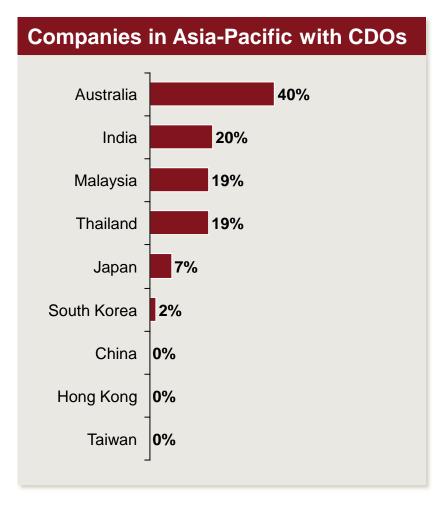

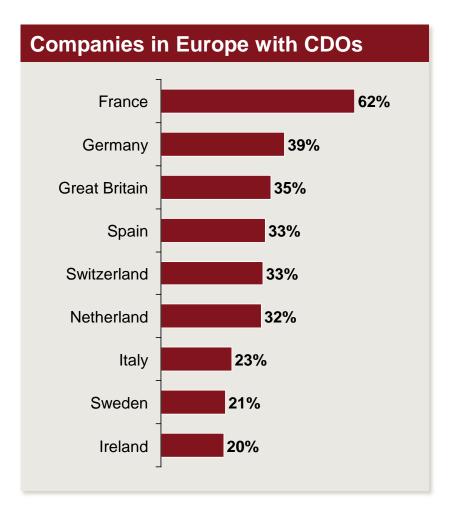
#### 2 38% of companies in EMEA and 23% in North America have a Chief Digital Officer

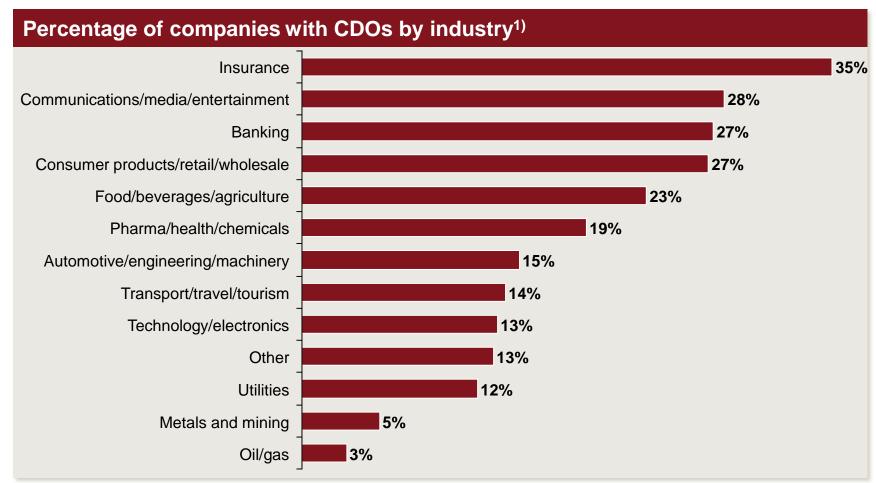
### **2** CDOs in Asia-Pacific and European countries 1)





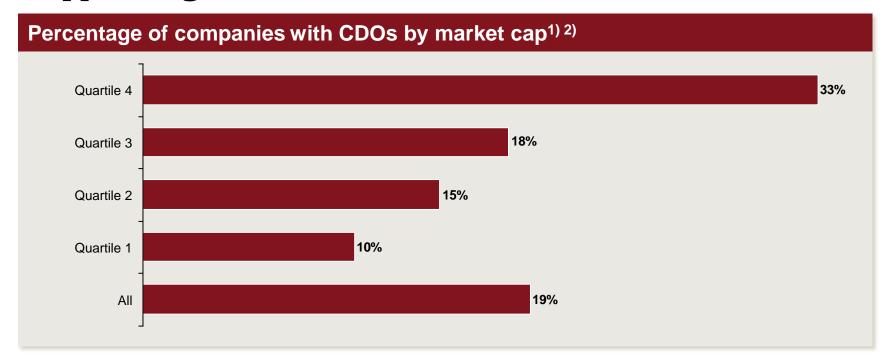

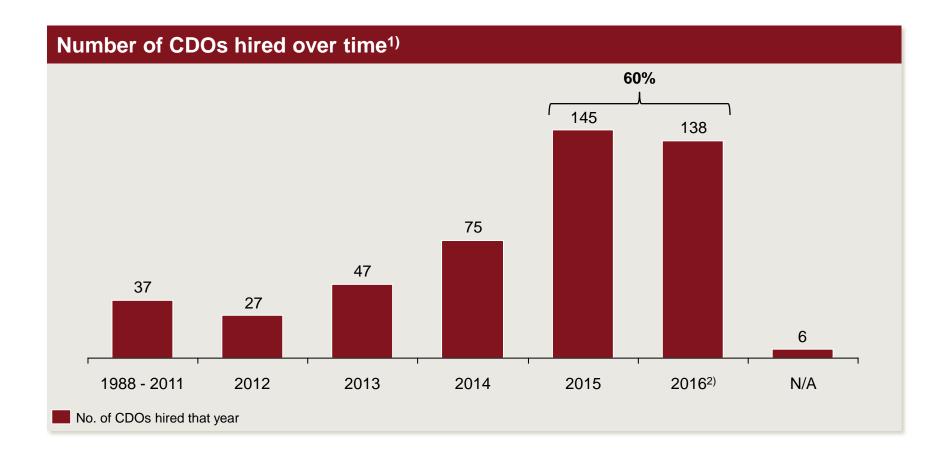
### **4** Larger companies tend to be ahead of the curve in appointing CDOs

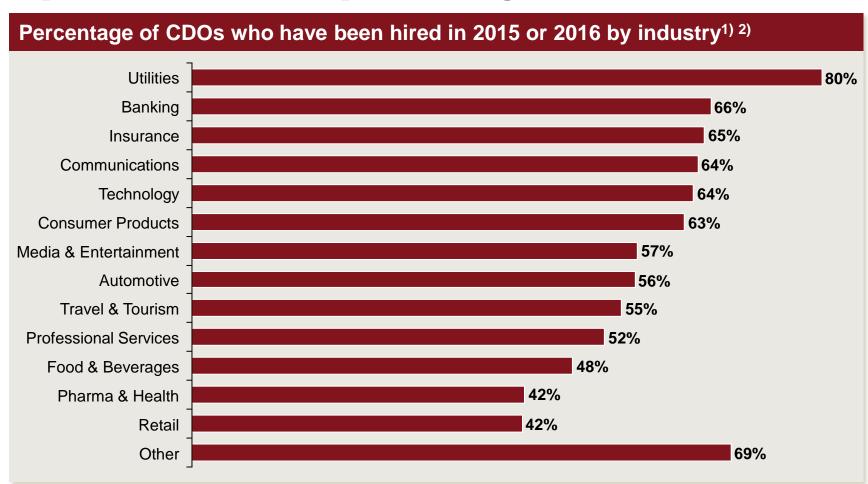

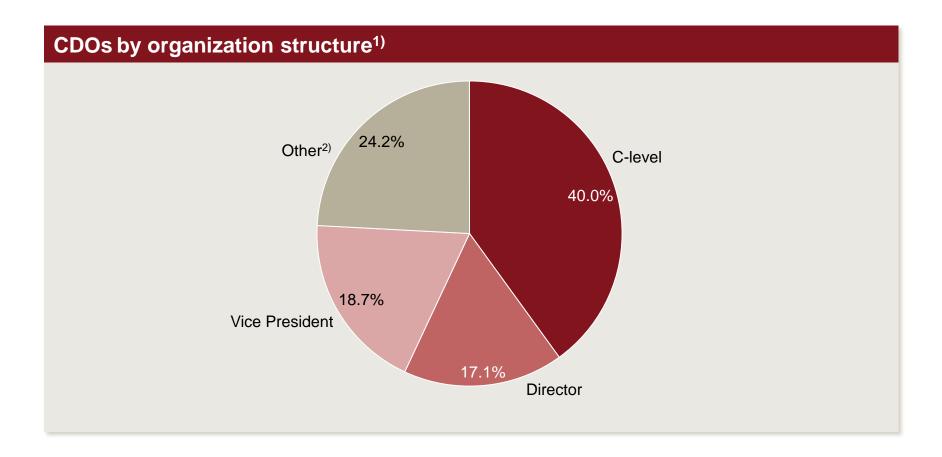
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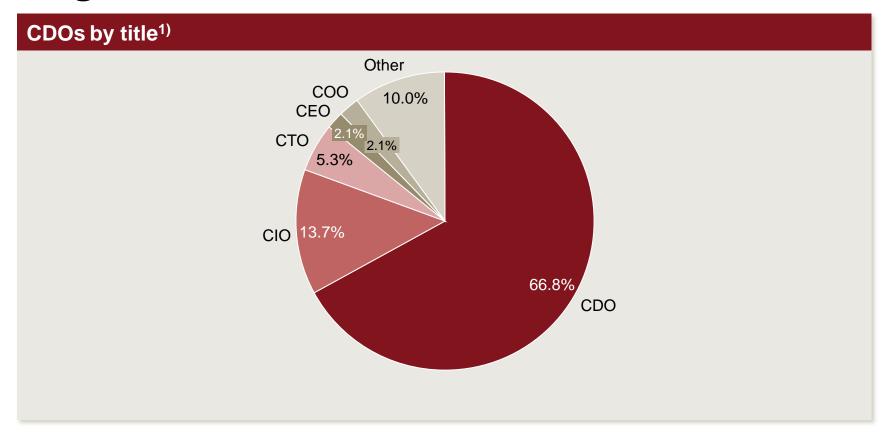

### Out of the C-Suite members 67% have the title "Chief Digital Officers"

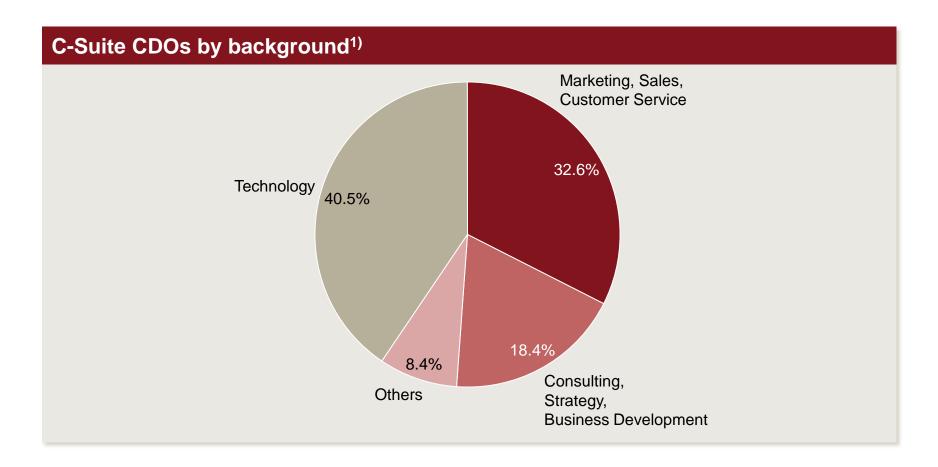

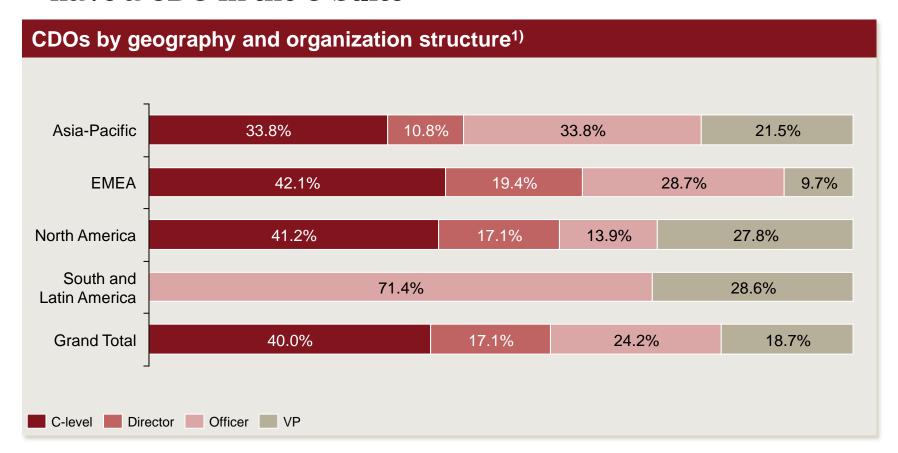
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### 7 41% of the C-Suite CDOs have a technology background



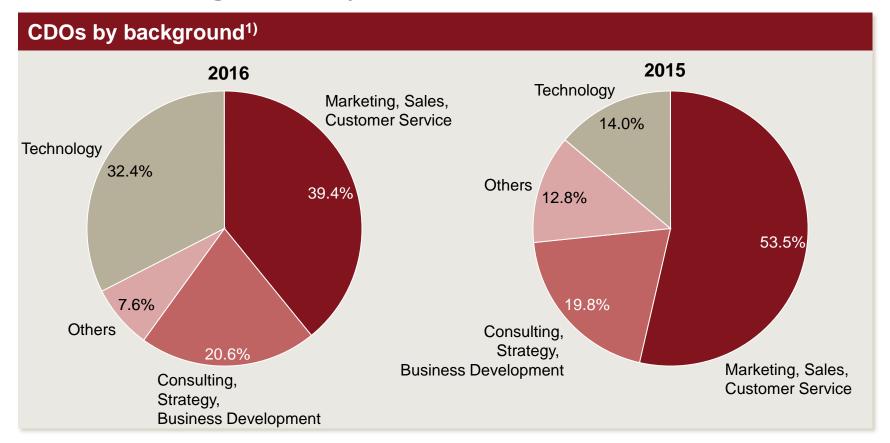

### **7** Companies in EMEA and North America are more likely to have a CDO in the C-Suite



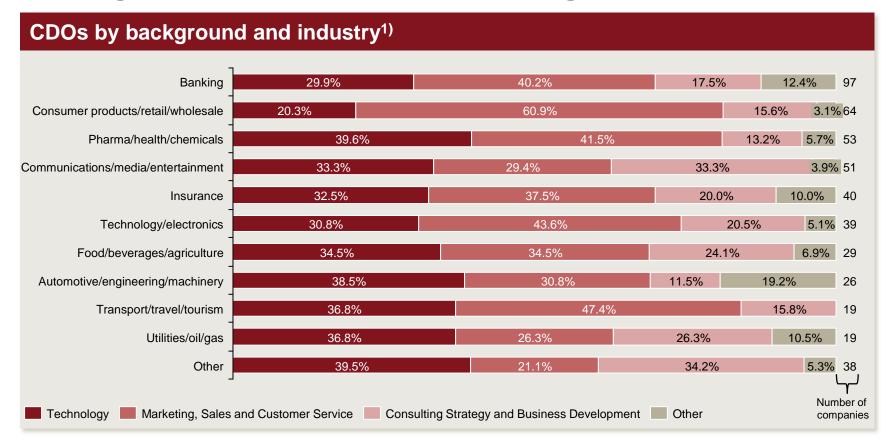

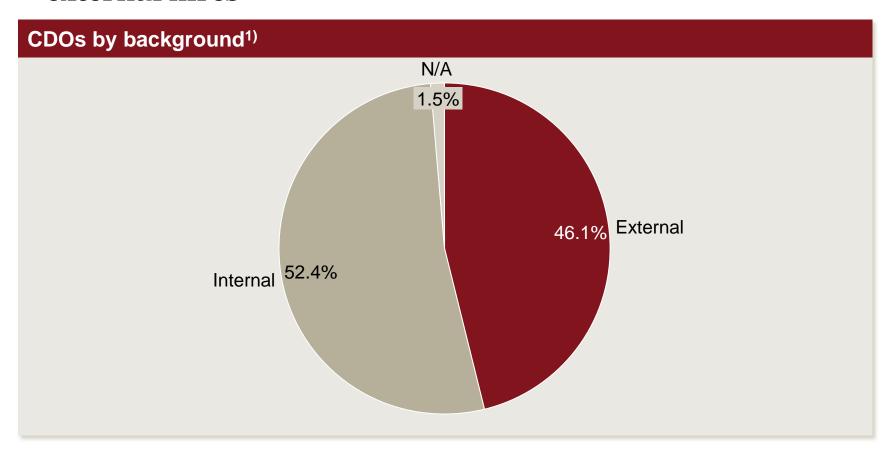
#### **B** Technology and Marketing, Sales and Customer Service backgrounds are the dominant throughout the industries

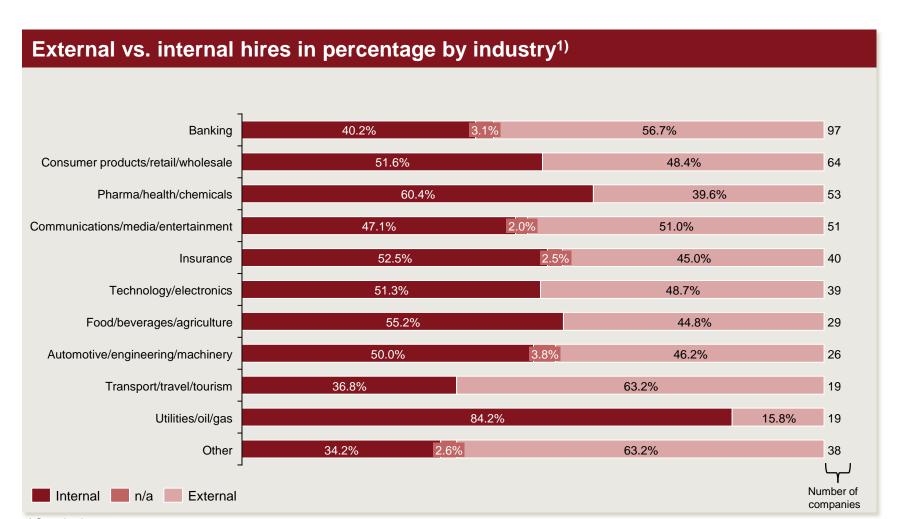

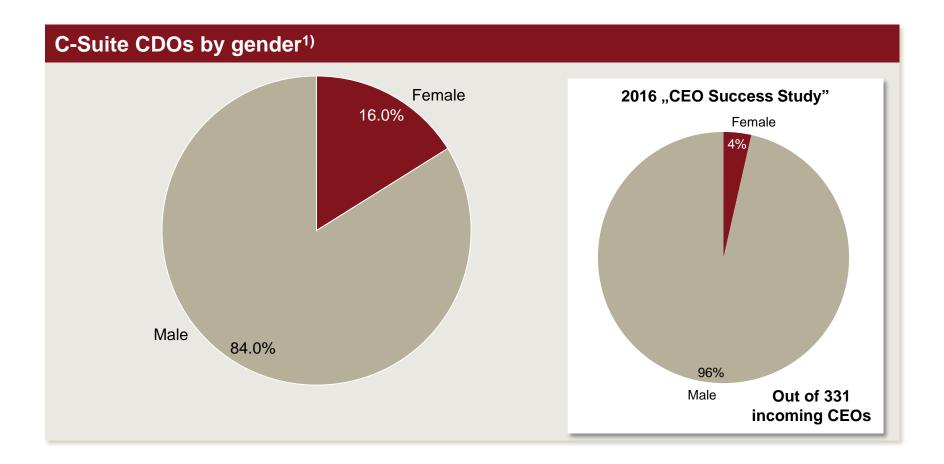
### External versus internal hires vary by industry

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#### **Methodology**

### Definition of a CDO

We define the CDO as that executive, no matter of the title, who has been given the task of putting into practice the digital mission of his or her company or business unit. This could be a high level member of the C-Suite; variously called the CDO, CTO, CIO, CSO or else – whose presence is critical in helping define his or her company's overall strategic direction and bringing about its cross-functional transformation into a full digital enterprise.

- Global top 2,500 listed companies by market cap as of July 1st, 2016
